

HC quashes detention order of detainee

JAMMU: Justice Rahul Bharti of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court has quashed the detention order of a detainee citing serious concerns about the grounds of detention being based on a "caricatured" opinion instead of an objective assessment.

Justice Rahul Bharti observed, "If taken as it is, then any law abiding citizen can be stereotyped at the hands of law and enforcement agency/authority for the sake of being put behind the bars not for any penal act of omission and commission on his/her part amounting to violation of

law but just for the reason that law and enforcement agency/authority is so profiling a person to be a bad person".

The case involved Waqas Riyaz Khan, a 26-year-old resident of Srinagar, who filed a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The petitioner sought a writ of habeas corpus to challenge the preventive detention order issued against him under Section 8 of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Safety Act, 1978. The detention order was issued by the District Magistrate, Srinagar, based on a dossier submitted by the Senior Superintendent

of Police (SSP), Srinagar, alleging the petitioner's involvement in anti-national activities.

The grounds for preventive detention outlined in the dossier portrayed the petitioner as having a radical ideology inclined towards terrorism, instigating youth, and providing logistics to anti-national elements. The SSP also referenced the petitioner's past involvement in cases related to the 2019 unrest, emphasizing his potential to disturb the peace and tranquility of the region.

Justice Bharti found the grounds of detention fact-deficient and lacking any context. He criticized the

dossier for presenting a mere opinionated caricature of Khan, devoid of concrete evidence or specific instances to support the accusations.

"The grounds of detention text wise spelled out by the respondent no. 2-District Magistrate, Srinagar lack a context and, therefore, do not and cannot count the basis for generating a subjective satisfaction which is meant to operate to an objective situation in front", the court said. Justice Bharti further underscored that while subjective satisfaction is crucial in preventive detention cases, it cannot disregard the necessity of presenting

an objective basis before the detention authority.

"It is exercise of subjective satisfaction under preventive detention jurisdiction which is meant to be respected but that does not mean that the said subjective satisfaction can dispense with state of objectivity to be produced before the detention authority to apply its mind and draw a subjective satisfaction for the purpose of subjecting a person to suffer preventive detention," the bench observed.

Based on these observations, the Court quashed Khan's detention order and ordered his immediate release.

End of Panchayat Raj in J&K

BJP Govt failed to hold elections due to fear of defeat: Congress

JAMMU: Congress has said that Panchayat Raj system has collapsed today due to expiring of term of Panchayats in J&K and said that BJP has deliberately delayed the Panchayat elections due to fear of defeat.

JKPCC has said that BJP deliberately delayed the elections and the Panchayat Raj system collapsed today in J&K, which is great injustice to the people of J&K who are without a democratic Govt. since June 2018.

Last assembly elections were held in December 2014, but assembly elections in J&K are due since 2018 but now in January 2024, no one know the timing of assembly elections, said JKPCC Senior Vice President and Chief Spokesperson Ravinder Sharma. He said that BJP wanted to control the powers in the hands of few bureaucrats to easily run through remote control from centre to carry out the propaganda and publicity of the BJP Govt. through the administrative machinery, for the upcoming elections. The entire administrative and field machinery is on publicity job of the BJP Govt. with an eye on general elections, he added.

People's aspirations and rights do not matter to the ruling BJP, which is now evidently clear, adding that ULB and Panchayats were the last symbols of democracy left in J&K. The Govt. was supposed to complete these elections one month prior to the completion of their present term of Panchayats & ULB, he added.

JAMMU: District Magistrate Sachin Kumar Vaishya on Tuesday conducted a surprise inspection of government institutions across the tehsils in the western part of the district and took stock of their functioning and delivery of public services.

The DM visited Sub Division Hospital Akhnor and reviewed the medicare facilities, infrastructure, and staff attendance.

He found some staff members absent from the duty and sought their explanation. He also directed the concerned

He expressed his strong feelings about punctuality and sincere delivery of public services. He warned of strict action if they failed to improve their punctuality and work ethics.

The District Magistrate emphasised that the district administration would not tolerate any laxity or negligence in the discharge of duties and responsibilities. He stated that the purpose of these surprise visits was to ensure accountability and responsiveness among government officials and to improve the quality of governance and administration.
