Jan Aushadhi Kendra sales increase 11 fold in Jammu Distt

The noteworthy development is substantiated by sample data collected from selected Jan Aushadhi Kendras located in Community Health Centres in Akhnor; Bishnah, RS Pura, Kot Bhalwal, and Chowki Choura, along with Government Hospitals Gandhi Nagar and Sarwal. According to data compiled on Friday by the District Health Society, the cumulative sale figures from the outlets for the current financial year since January 2023 amounted to ₹27,14,487. With sustained efforts and support from the district administration to promote Jan Aushadhi Kendras, the most recent sales data has surged to ₹3,16,15,919, marking an impressive increase of around 11.6 times. With an objective of making quality generic medicines available at affordable prices to all, Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) was launched by the Government of India in November, 2008. Under the scheme, dedicated outlets known as Janaushadhi Kendras are opened to provide generic medicines at affordable prices. Product basket of PMBJP comprises 1965 drugs and 293 surgical items.
