Electors who wish to apply for correction to their particulars can submit Form 2-C (Correction). For shifting of names from one place to another due to change of residence, an Elector can apply in Form 2-D (Transposition) before the concerned Electoral Registration Officers, (EROs) / Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs) and Panchayat Election Booth Officials (PEBOs).
