KDP Wing of DPAP highlights demands of displaced people

STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: In a joint statement issued by the Leaders of Kashmiri Displaced People (KDP) Wing of Democratic Progressive Azad Party (DPAP) through Sanjay Dhar Lal President, Piaray Pandita Chairman, Raj Kumar Ticku General Secretary, Naveen Gosani Youth President have highlighted demands.




