

JAMMU: The Administrative Council has approved absorption of 145 permanent employees of the Centaur Lake View Hotel, Srinagar in Sher-i-Kashmir International Convention Centre (SKICC), Jammu and Kashmir Cable Car Corporation Ltd (JKCCC) and Jammu and Kashmir Tourism Development Corporation Ltd, Srinagar (JKTDC) with effect from March 1,.2023 instead of May 22,-2023.

This is in pursuance to the process of outsourcing of the assets of Tourism Department. Administrative Council in its decision dated 22-05-2023 had approved absorption of these employees with effect from 22-05-2023 and Government Order No. $86\text{-}\mathrm{JK}(\mathrm{TSM})$ of 2023 dated 12.07.2023 was issued in this behalf.


'Rammay' Ayodhya set for consecration ceremony




