JAMMU: Jammu and Kashmir Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) on Saturday described the recent claims suggesting that the recent transfer of personnel from the organization was a punitive action for exposing corruption, as entirely misleading and factually incorrect.

In a statement, the ACB stated, "Transfer is a normal administrative procedure and an incidence of service, and the government remains committed to ensuring that efforts against corruption continue without disruption. One of the officers, transferred recently from the Anti Corruption Bureau had served in the organization for more than six years, far exceeding the usual tenure for officers in such postings while the other two have also completed tenures of 3 years. These transfers were long overdue and in line with standard rotational policies followed across government departments. The claim that

these officers were removed for challenging corruption is baseless. In fact, the process of personnel rotation in the Bureau was initiated in the year 2023, but due to certain administrative exigencies, these transfers got delayed. Attempts to portray a routine transfer as politically motivated,

distort the facts and undermine public trust in institutions. None of these officers are associated with the investigation or supervision of investigation of any FIRs recently registered in the Anti Corruption Bureau. The ACB remains fully operational and continues its man-

date of investigating corruption cases without bias or external influence. Routine transfers do not affect the agency's work or integrity, and the government remains committed to transparency, accountability, and due process in its fight against corruption.

Take help of 'Drone Didis' in preparing Gharauni: Yogi

LUCKNOW: Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Saturday directed the Revenue Department to complete land surveys for gharauni certificate in the villages within the stipulated time. During distribution of 45.35 lakh gharauni certificates to residents of over 29,000 villages, to expedite the process, the CM directed the department to collaborate with the Survey of India and seek assistance from 'Drone Didis' for drone based surveys.

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Saturday said in the gharauni certificate distribution program under the ownership scheme through video conferencing by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at his official residence and more than 45 lakh 35 thousand



gharauni certificate of more than 29 thousand villages were distributed on Saturday. Earlier, Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually

inaugurated the program by pressing the button. During this, he also interacted with the beneficiaries of various states and on this occasion CM Yogi Adityanath distributed Gharauni certificate to many beneficiaries at his official residence in Lucknow. Prime Minister Narendra Modi interacted with the beneficiaries of gharauni certificate of Uttar Pradesh in the program and got information about its benefits from them. After this, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, while addressing the beneficiaries of Gharauni certificate said that earlier the strongmen used to occupy 3 to 4 feet of the poor's land by moving it here and there. Whereas under the Swamitva Yojana, the poor are being given their rights through drone surveys. Prime Minister

Narendra Modi has given the poor their real rights through drone surveys. The CM said that till now more than one crore people have distributed gharauni certificate. The remaining 25 thousand will be distributed in Gharauni soon. The CM said that this is the first time after independence that people settled on populated land in rural areas are being given legal rights to their land. There are more than 57,000 Gram Panchayats in Uttar Pradesh. The work of construction of one Gram Sachivalaya is going on in each of these Gram Panchayats, due to which employment is being created in every village. Today in the new Uttar Pradesh of New India, every Gram Panchayat is giving employment to five to seven people.
