

CS visits AIIMS Jammu, emphasises collaboration to enhance healthcare in J&K

JAMMU: Chief Secretary, Atal Dulloo on Saturday during his visit to AIIMS Jammu interacted with the faculty of the institute to assess the facilities being provided to patients there besides taking stock of issues, if any, confronting them.

The Chief Secretary was accompanied by Ramesh Kumar, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, Dr Syed Abid Rasheed Shah, Secretary, Health & Medical Education Department and Rajesh Sharma, Deputy Commissioner, Samba.

Professor Shakti Kumar Gupta, ED & CEO, AIIMS Jammu, highlighted the key facilities available in AIIMS Jammu, including the Library, Poison Information and Management Centre, OPD, IPD, Emergency Department and the Blood Bank.

The Chief Secretary commended the efforts of AIIMS Jammu in delivering quality healthcare. He emphasised the importance of collaboration among AIIMS, UT Government, IITs and IIMs to address healthcare challenges in far flung areas of this region effectively.

In his address, Atal Dulloo highlighted the urgent need to focus on improving medical infrastructure in hilly and remote areas, where healthcare accessibility is limited. He expressed confidence that collaborative efforts and innovative solutions could significantly enhance the quality and reach of medical services in such regions.

He sought support from this elite health institution to use their human and technological resources to reach out to areas which lack access to

better medical facilities. He assured them that the administration would extend every possible support to them in such pursuits.

Dr. Syed Abid Rasheed Shah remarked on the pivotal role of AIIMS Jammu in advancing medical education, research and specialised care in Jammu

Whereas vide Govt. Order No. 22-DMRRR of 2017 dated: 2X03.2017, Department of DMRRR, further amendment vide State Administrative Council Decision No, 26/2020 dated: 05.02.2020 and Order No. 20-JK [DMRRR] of 2020 dated: 10.02.2020, the mandatory requirements for establishing the status of DP of 1965/71 to process the case file to the competent authority is as under:-

Ration Card of 1965/71 of Camp (self attested) or copy of Voter list of period prior to 1965/71 attested by election Naib Tehsildar or certified Revenue documents of land at previous place of residence [i.e before displacement) or certified Revenue extract of allotted land after displacement or relevant extract of register cancellation duty certified or receipt of NHRC relief of Rs 25000/- per family for Non camp DPs.

Whereas, the case files furnished by the Tehsildars were scrutinized by the committee constituted and found incomplete files i.e deficient documents to established the status of DP/Lineage tree of the original DP/residence/revenue extract.

Whereas, this office is unable to process the case files for one time financial assistance settlement schemes, being incomplete case files due to non submission of mandatory documents to the competent authority.

The details of cases with deficient mandatory documents which cannot be approved for financial assistance or details as Annexure 'A'

Therefore, the beneficiaries are invited/ informed through the medium of this notice to fulfil the deficiency being mandatory requirements within 10 (Ten) days from the issuance/publication of this notice. Failure to provide the required documents shall render this office to reject the case.
