CBC Poonch organises Swachata Awareness programme

POONCH: The Central Bureau of Communication (CBC) Poonch organized an awareness program on the 'Swachhta Action Plan' (SAP) at Government Higher Secondary School, Chandak, Block Nangali Sahab Sai Baba, in the Poonch district of Jammu and Kashmir. The primary objective of the program was to encourage

citizens to adopt cleanliness habits. Participants were urged to dispose of waste in a responsible manner and to recognize the urgency of maintaining a clean and green India. Emphasis was placed on rejecting single-use plastic and participating in the 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' campaign by planting and nurturing saplings. Principal GHSS Chandak, Sh. Amil Hussain expressed his appreciation for the efforts of the Government of India and CBC for organizing the program in the remote area of Chandak. He reminded the students of their role in maintaining cleanliness and cited examples of Mahatma Gandhi and Prime Minister Narendra Modi, highlighting their commitment to a cleaner and greener India. He encouraged students to dedicate one hour every week to cleanliness and to protect trees. On the occasion, Naib

Tehsildar Chandak, Naseer Choudhary, discussed the goals of the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM). He spoke about the responsible disposal of waste, waste segregation and the mantra of "Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle" for effective waste management. Panchayat Secretary, RDD & Panchayati Raj, Chandak-B, Himani Manhas shared insights on the achievements of the Rural Development Department (RDD) in the area. She informed the gathering about the establishment of segregation sheds, composite pits, and soak pits in the panchayats, along with a plastic waste management unit at Chandak. She also highlighted that each panchayat has dedicated segregation sheds and Swachhgrahis to manage waste. Incharge CBC Poonch, Vijay Mattoo emphasized the significance of activities such as Shramdaan (community

service), distribution of jute bags and dustbins, and organising seminars aimed to inspire the youth to contribute to a clean India. He noted that CBC organizes similar programs across Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh regions. In addition to the 'Swachhta Pledge' a cleanliness drive was also organized within the school premises, encouraging students, teachers, and locals to contribute to the 'Swachh Vidhalay' (Clean School) initiative. A theme-based dance performance, songs, and a skit were presented by the PRT of CBC J&K, urging the audience to reconsider their daily routines that contribute to pollution. Students also shared their views on cleanliness through speeches. As part of the event, CBC Poonch donated dustbins, brooms, masks, gloves, sanitizers and jute bags to the school.

MENDHAR: Balnoi Battalion of the Indian Army in collaboration with People's Hut Foundation, Diva International and State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organisation (SOTTO) J&K conducted a "Free Medical and Organ Donation Awareness Camp" at Balnoi Base, Sub Division Mendhar, Tehsil - Mankote, District Poonch. The main aim of conducting this medical camp was to provide essential free health care services to the villagers in the Area of responsibility of Balnoi Battalion. The People's Hut Foundation headed by Dr. Rohit Koul which is a national level registered NGO registered with Govt of India & Niti Aayog brought together a team of dedicated health care professionals who volunteered to offer medical consultations. The SOTTO J&K was also invited and was represented by Dr. Irfan Ahmed Lone, Transplant Coordinator SOTTO J&K. He shared the importance of Organ Donation and clarified some myths that people have when it comes to organ donation and transplantation. The medical camp themed "Mobile Health Clinic Program" saw an overwhelming participation where more than 487 patients availed the

free services from villages of Mankote Block. In addition to medical consultation in the Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, Dentistry, ENT, Pathology, General medicine, Ophthalmology the camp also provided free Allopathic Medicines basic health screening and awareness about Nutrition, Hygiene and preventive care. The medical camp provided medical services to all villages in Mendhar, including Balnoi, Dabraj, Sagra, Ghani and Mankote, which lack basic medical facilities due to their proximity to the Line of Control. A special grievance and service camp for the people of Balnoi and nearby villages was also organized by J&K Bank in collaboration with People's Hut Foundation under the supervision of Sh. Deepak Bhan, Chief Manager, J&K Bank with the assistance of Anoop Kumar and Amit Kumar Bali, Assistant Managers of the J&K Bank. It received a great response from the local people.
