Whereas, National Food Security Act, 2013 was implemented in J&K including district Kishitwar in 2016.
Whereas, socio-economic status of the families change with time and there hasn't been any re-verification of ration lists in the district since implementation of NFSA.
Whereas, a number of representations from general public are pouring in regarding inclusion of deserving households in the category of **AAV/Priority/Non-Priority/Exclusion** under National Food Security Act,2013 (NFSA) by the Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department.
Whereas, Vide Govt. Order No. 2129-JK(GAD) OF 2024 dated 24-12-2024, sanction has been accorded to the constitution of District Level Committee comprising of following for conducting verification of all beneficiaries enrolled in PDS database: -
District Level Committee.

i. Deputy Commissioner	Chairman
ii. Assistant Commissioner Revenue	Member
iii. Assistant Commissioner Development	Member
iv. District Social Welfare Officer	Member
v. Assistant Director FCS&CA	Member Secretary

Term of the reference of the committee

- To verify the eligibility of all beneficiaries enrolled in the database, in light of applicable rules, and ensure weeding out of ineligible beneficiaries therefrom.
- To ensure inclusion of left-out eligible beneficiaries, if any identified, in appropriate groups/ categories under PDS.
- To ensure completion of e-KYC of all pending beneficiaries eligible under PDS.

Whereas, vide SO 389, dated: 16/11/2021, criteria for identification of **Priority, Non-Priority & Exclusion** category households under NFSA has been revised and notified.

A): Criteria for Inclusion
i): Urban Areas:

- All Antyodaya Anna Yojana families;
- Households without shelter;
- Households with destitute person who is living on alms;
- Household headed by a widow or a single woman (unmarried/separated/deserted);
- Households headed by differently abled persons or Individual having disability of above forty percent or terminally ill;
- Transgender person;
- A household headed by Minor or orphan;
- Households dependent on daily wage labour;
- Household with old persons, aged sixty years or above with no regular income, support or no assured means of subsistence;
- If all earning adult members in a household are irregular wagers, then that household shall be included; and
- Other vulnerable households such as slum dwellers, ragpickers, unskilled Workers, Shikara walas, Ponnywalas, domestic workers, Sweepers, etc.

(ii) For Rural Areas:-

- All Antyodaya Anna Yojana families;
- Households without shelter;
- Households with destitute person who is living on alms;
- Household headed by a widow or a single woman (unmarried/separated/deserted);
- Households headed by differently abled persons or Individual having disability of above forty percent or terminal ill;
- Transgender person;
- A household headed by Minor or orphan;
- Household with old persons, aged sixty years or above with no regular income, support or no assured means of subsistence;
- Households dependent on agricultural labourers;
- Tribal Households with no regular source of income; and
- Other vulnerable households such as Shikara walas, Ponnywalas, potters, cobblers, domestic workers, Sweepers, etc.

B): Criteria for Exclusion

- Households with at least one member as income or professional tax payer,
- Businessmen having business turnover of Rs.25 lacs per year,
- Persons having land holding above 10 kanals in case of individuals and 20 kanals in case of joint family in urban areas. In rural areas the same shall be 30 kanals & 50 kanals respectively. (All based on self-declarations);
- All gazetted officers or equivalent rank in corporations, boards, PSUs etc;
- All persons holding constitutional authority/positions; and
- Any household having annual family income of more than Five lacs.

C): All the households, who are not included in either of the above criteria groups, shall be included in Non-Priority Category.

Moreover, in Urban areas concerned CEOs/EOs shall also be a member of Tehsil Level Committee and Sanitary Inspector for Ward/town Level Committee in Municipality.
The Committees shall carry out a pan district re-verification of eligible beneficiaries in the district as per existing rules. The terms of reference of the committees shall be as:

Village Level committee: -

- To organize Gram Sabha, read out the category wise lists, get objections regarding the lists and confirm or reject the objections.
- To identify and recommend the eligible beneficiaries for inclusion under AAY/Priority/Non-priority & Exclusion category.
- To identify and recommend the ineligible beneficiaries for exclusion from AAY/Priority/Non-priority category.
- To include the names of the left-out beneficiaries of the eligible ration card holders.
- To ensure completion of e-KYC of all pending beneficiaries eligible under PDS.

Tehsil Level Committee: -

- To ensure circulation of prescribed format/lists through FPS and at other permanent places in a time bound manner as per the schedule notified by this office.
- To collect the entire data and segregate the same as per criteria notified by the Govt. for AAY/Priority/Non-priority/exclusion category.
- To ensure submission of authentic and correct data after proper scrutiny to the District Level committee for consolidation.
- To generate maximum awareness about the verification process through Departmental functionaries at Tehsil/Village level.
- To oversee and monitor the functioning of Village Level Committees on daily basis.

District Level committee: -

- To collect the entire data and segregate the same as per criteria notified by the Govt. for AAY/Priority/Non-priority/exclusion category.
- To oversee and monitor the functioning of Tehsil Level Committees on daily basis.
- To generate maximum awareness about the verification process through print and electronic media.
- To get the necessary changes done on the Departmental portal (RCMS) within the district ceilings once approval of the revised lists is accorded by the District level committee.

The above-mentioned Committees shall complete the process in time bound manner. However, the committees shall ensure that the targets/ceilings assigned to the district for inclusion of families/beneficiaries under different categories are taken care of and in no circumstances exceeded.
