- 1. Whereas, the proper indent was placed by Genral Manager Chenab Valley Power Project Private Limited vide communication No:CVPP/PDHEPP/LAND/2012/216 Dated:- 23.11.2012, and Chief Engineer Kirthai/HEPPs/292-95. Dated:26.10.2015 for acquisition of land for construction of Pakal Dool HE Project at Village Kwartenji, Tehsil & District Kishtwar, before the Collector Land Acquisition ACR Kishtwar; and
- Whereas, the Collector under rules and as per the provisions of J&K Land Acquisition Act issued notifications U/S 4 (i), Sec-6&7, Sec-9&9A followed by Final Award from this office Vide No. ACR/K/2016/Award/01-10. Dated:- 10-02-2016, for Land Measuring 1193Kls 04Mls comprising of Structures, Fruit Bearing Trees and Non-Fruit Trees and No: ACR/LA/Award/2017/1502. Dated:- 08-05-2017, for Land Measuring 56Kls 09Mls comprising of Structures, and Fruit Bearing Tree; and
- Whereas, some of the aggrieved landowners' filled objections/representations before this office as well as before Deputy Commissioner, Kishtwar for assessment and payment of left-out fruit bearing trees and structures of Arzi Village coming under the alignment of Pakal Dul HEPP. Accordingly, a commission was constituted and joint inspection was conducted by the concerned technical departments at the relevant point of time and also submitted assessment of left-out fruit bearing trees and structures; and
- Whereas, the endorsement made by the indenting agency pertaining to left out fruit bearing trees has been received in this office Vide No. CVPP/PDHEP/CGM/2020/265 Dated: 06-03-2020 interalia, authorizing the collector for further disbursement to the amount of Rs. 17,96,500/=/= including Jabrana@15%; and
- Whereas, the endorsement made by the indenting agency regarding authentication of left out structures has been received in this office Vide No. CVPP/PDHEP/CGM/2020-318 Dated: 17-03-2020 followed by the letter no. CVPP/PDHEP/GM (I/c)/2024/990 Dated: 21-08-2024 interalia, authorizing the collector for further disbursement to the amount of Rs. 29,00,300/=including Jabrana@15%; and
- Whereas, it is the settled principle of law that all the reassessments done on the basis of the consideration of the objections filed by the landowners beyond the mandatory period as warranted under law shall have to treated as null and void and only such assessments conducted under rules and duly endorsed by the indenting agency as well as the respective agencies are to the considered; and
- Whereas, the matter regarding the amount to be incorporated in the supplementary award was considered and case file was put before District Collector on 14.12.2024 for approval and necessary directions and District Collector has granted the approval for the case file on 16.12.2024 for finalizing the compensation, as arrived after assessing the revised number of left out fruit bearing trees and structures, done by the concerned technical departments; and
- Whereas, the amount involved in finalizing the compensation, as arrived after assessing the revised number of


- -9. Whereas, it is the settled principle of law that all the reassessments done on the basis of the consideration of the objections filed by the landowners beyond the mandatory period as warranted under law shall have to treated as null and void and only such assessments conducted under rules and duly endorsed by the indenting agency as well as the respective agencies are to the considered; and
- 10. Whereas, it is pertinent to mention here that the Hon'ble High Court in the Judgment passed in case titled Divisional Commissioner Srinagar V/S Gh. Nabi Butt and Ors has adjudicated the matter, the relevant part of which is reproduced as under:-

"10. As a sequel to the above discussion, we uphold the view of the learned single judge in its conclusion but substitute the reasoning adopted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Mohanji's case (supra). in other words there is no impediments for payment of compensation by the state by publishing a supplementary award in respect of the trees, super-structures and machinery, if the same has been omitted in the original award. It is further clarified that payment of compensation in respect of the super-structure, trees and machinery would not result into lapse of proceedings having gone beyond a period of two years. Therefore, the learned Single Judge has rightly directed the appellants to re-consider the matter and pay to the writ petitioners-respondents their dues even in respect of super-structures, machinery and trees.11.

Now, therefore, in pursuance to the Hon'ble High Court judgment/directions in the case titled Divisional Commissioner Srinagar V/S GhNabi Butt and Ors, the facts and circumstances associated with the instant case, I, Idrees Lone (JKAS) Collector Land Acquisition, Kishtwar do hereby circulate the Draft Supplementary Award for inviting objections, if any, by all concerned within a period of 15 (Fifteen) days to the extent of Rs.48,14,221/= Forty Eight Lakhs Fourteen Thousands Two Hundred and Twenty One Rupees Only) for Structures and Fruit Bearing Trees, duly verified and authenticated by the Horticulture Department/Forest Department/Public Works (R&B) and endorsed by the Indenting Agency i.e General Manager Pakal Dul Hydro Electric Project, coming under the alignment of Pakal Dul Hydro Electric Project Village Arzi.
