This system automatically opens rotary valves at regular intervals to collect dust particles and other particulate matter in the collection bag and release clean air into the atmosphere through an exhaust open-

ing" he added. Agriculture Research Engineer, Er. Bhardwaj Kumar explained that the pulse jet bag filter, with a process ing capacity of 5.0 TPH, been specially has designed and fabricated to meet the requirements of the Jammu seed processing plant and procured under the CAPEX Budget after following all necessary formalities. "The installation of this equipment is a crucial step towards mitigating the environmental hazards caused by dust pollution in and around the Seed Processing Complex" he informed.

The advanced filtration system is expected to significantly reduce dust pollution, improve the working environment, and ensure compliance with environmental standards.
