eligibility for (Anganwadi Worker)

1. Female Candidates in the age group of 18-37 Years shall be considered for the post.
2. The Candidate should be a domicile of the UT of J&K.
3. The Candidate should be a resident of the Electoral ward where AWC is situated. Name in the voter list for the ward shall be considered as the proof of residence of the candidates. In case the name of the candidates appears in the voter list along with her parents, then she must provide certificate of being unmarried issued by the concerned Tehsildar. Where ever, there is any dispute as to residence for any reason, then a residence proof certifying the wards of residence from the concerned the SDM/ACR shall be considered.
4. Minimum Qualification for Anganwadi Worker shall be 10+2 Pass and Maximum Graduation. In case no 10+2 Pass Candidates is available the Ward, 10+2 pass Candidates from the adjoining ward shall be considered which would require prior approval of Mission Director, Mission Poshan.
5. In Case suitable Candidates is not Available for adjoining ward, candidates from the nearest ward within the ward can be considered subject to be approval of the MD Mission Poshan.
6. Weightage shall be given on the basis of marks obtained in 10+2 and selection shall be done purely on merit basis & no other criteria to be considered.
7. In case of tie in merit of the eligible candidate, candidate with higher age will be preferred. Candidates with qualification higher than graduation shall not be considered.

- B. The Selection of helper shall be restricted to the electoral ward where Anganwadi Centres is located.**

 1. Women Candidates in the age Group of 18-37 Years shall be eligible.
 2. The Candidates must be domicile of the UT of J&K
 3. Minimum Qualification for Anganwadi Helper shall be matriculation.
 4. In Case no matriculate candidates available in the ward, candidates with qualification not less than 8th standard shall be considered.
 5. The Committee shall select the most destitute /needy married women of the ward as helper from amongst those who fulfill the qualification criteria. In Case no married candidates is available, unmarried candidates may be considered.
 6. In case eligible Candidates is available within the family of retiring AWW/AWHs, the said candidates shall qualify for additional two percent points.

DOCUMENTS VERIFICATION:-

1. The candidate who is short listed for the Documents verification will be required to appear for Documents Verification along with the original documents as well as self attested photo state copy of each documents as per the advertisement notification. The candidates must be in possession of the prescribed academic qualification and other documents like Domicile Certificate, on or before the last date of submission application form.

NOTIFICATION

S.O. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and Commencement.-(1) These rules may be called Jammu and Kashmir Government Homeopathic Medical College Kathua (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2025.
 (2) These rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Government Gazette.

2. Definitions.-(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
a. "Administrative Department" means the Health and Medical Education Department;
b. "Cadre" means the cadre of the service
c. "Commission" means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
d. "Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
e. "Head of the Department" means the Principal/Head of the institution;
f. "Member of the Service Means" a person appointed to a post in the Service under these rules;
g. "Post" means the permanent post carrying a definite time-scale of pay sanctioned by the competent authority;
h. "Rules" means the Government Homeopathic Medical College, Kathua Gazetted Service Recruitment Rules, 2025;
i. "Schedules" means the schedules annexed to these rules;
j. "Service" means the Government Homeopathic Medical College, Kathua (Gazetted) Service; and
k. "UT" means the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir

(2) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to it in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations, 1956;

3. Constitution of Services.-(1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the Govt. Homeopathic Medical College, Kathua (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2025.

(2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person is eligible for appointment and is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the Service.

Explanation.-The word 'holding' means a person occupying a sanctioned post included in the cadre of the service on regular basis under orders of the competent authority.

4. Strength and Composition of the Service.-(1) The authorized strength of the cadre and nature of the posts included therein shall be specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules;

5. Qualification and method of recruitment.-(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post unless he/she possesses the qualification and fulfills other requirements as laid down in Schedule-II

(2) **Appointment to the Service shall be made-**
 a. By direct recruitment; or
 b. By promotion; or
 c. By deputation/selection, as specified against each post in the schedule -II.

6. Probation.-(1) Probation shall be governed by the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

7. Reservation in appointments.-While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be made in accordance with the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules framed thereunder.

8. Training and Departmental Examination Persons appointed by direct recruitment shall undergo such training and pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

9. Maintenance of seniority lists.-Seniority of the members of the Service shall be maintained as per the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

10. One time exemption -As one time exemption, in case of non availability of eligible candidates for the post of Principal and Associate Professor, the following exemption shall be made for recruitment to the post of Principal and Associate Professor as under;

A. For the post of Principal. In case of non availability of eligible members, the selection shall be made from eligible medical officers/ Assistant Professors of Government Homeopathic Medical College Kathua having post Graduation in any discipline, with 05 years of administrative experience and total service of minimum 20 years.

B. Post of Associate Professor: In case of non availability of eligible members from feeding cadre, the post can be filled up as one time absorption by way of lateral entry by selection from Health/Ayush Department from amongst the senior medical officers in Homeopathy having not less than 5 years of experience in regular service after acquiring post graduate degree in subject concerned or any subject if not available and having 01 publications as Principal or Co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal and must have qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the commission.

11. Residuary Matters. In matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations applicable to the UT Civil Service in general.

12. Interpretation. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department whose decision shall be final
