



# Ch Zulfkar expresses concern over lack of basic amenities

**BUDHAL:** Former Cabinet Minister of Jammu and Kashmir and UT Vice President of the Bharatiya Janata Party, Chowdhary Zulfkar Ali, undertook an extensive tour of the remote areas of the Budhal Assembly Constituency, including Samaut, Gabbar, Dandod, and Rajnagar, to review public issues and interact directly with local residents. During the tour, people raised serious concerns about the lack of basic facilities in the region. Residents complained of an acute shortage of potable drinking water; irregular and poor electricity supply with frequent power cuts, shortage of essential food grains, dilapidated road conditions, and inadequate staff in schools and healthcare centres. A large number of youth also expressed anxiety over growing unemployment and lack of livelihood opportunities.

Chowdhary Zulfkar Ali was accompanied by Manzoor Naik, General Secretary, BJP ST Morcha, along with local Panchs, Sarpanchs, party leaders, and respected community members. He listened patiently to the grievances of the people and assured them that their issues would be taken up at the appropriate level. Expressing serious concern over the situation, Zulfkar Ali criticised the Jammu and Kashmir Government for failing to fulfil the promises made during the 2024 Assembly elections. He said that instead of improving, the condition of the people has worsened over the last one and a half years, reflecting poor governance and lack of commitment.

He specifically referred to the unfulfilled promises of free LPG cylinders, free ration, and employment to one lakh youth every year. He also stated that although the Government of India under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched several welfare schemes for unemployed youth, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and people living in backward and remote areas, the UT Government has failed to ensure their proper implementation on the ground.

**RAJOURI:** Senior Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader and former Member of Legislative Council (MLC), Vibodh Gupta while addressing a worker meeting at Dassal said that the Modi government's decision to reform and modernise the rural employment guarantee programme, including its restructuring, is aimed purely at enhancing benefits for rural workers, while the Congress party is deliberately misleading and manipulating people for narrow political interests.

"Viksit Bharat - Guarantee for Rozgar and Ajeevika Mission (Gramin) Act, 2025', has increased the number of workdays under it would be increased from 100 days at present to 125 days", said Vibodh. He strongly asserted that instead of focusing on names, Congress should explain why during its rule MGNREGA was synonymous with corruption, fake job cards, delayed wages, and massive leakages," he said.

Vibodh said that under the Modi government, the rural employment scheme has become more transparent, accountable, and

worker-friendly through Aadhaar-based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT), geo-tagging of assets, digital attendance, and regular social audits. "These reforms have ensured that wages reach genuine beneficiaries on time and public money is not siphoned off by middlemen, which was rampant during Congress regimes," he added.

Vibodh also highlighted that the Modi government's broader welfare initiatives such as PM Awas Yojana, PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, Ujjwala Yojana, Jal Jeevan Mission, Ayushman Bharat, and Swachh Bharat Abhiyan have complemented rural employment efforts and significantly improved living standards in villages.

Senior BJP leader and former Sarpanch Kewal Sharma said that the Modi government has ushered in a new era of inclusive and development-oriented governance, with welfare schemes reaching the poorest sections directly and transparently. He said initiatives such as PM Awas

Yojana, PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, Ayushman Bharat, Ujjwala Yojana, Jal Jeevan Mission and improved rural employment programmes have significantly strengthened livelihoods, improved living standards, and ensured dignity for the poor.

**Subject: Allotment of State land in favour of each family for residential purposes who have become landless due to Natural Calamity (i.e. floods, landslides, cloudburst, earthquakes) in Jammu and Kashmir.**

**Ref: Council of Ministers Decision No. 144/19/2025 dated 22.12.2025**

**Government Order No:01-JK(REV) of 2026**  
**Dated:02.01.2026**

In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 15 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Grants Rules, 2022, sanction is hereby accorded to the grant of state land measuring 05 Marla in favour of each landless family rendered landless due to recent Natural Calamities (i.e. floods, landslide, cloudbursts, earthquakes) in 2025 in Jammu and Kashmir on lease basis for residential purposes, without charging any premium and an annual ground rent of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only) per Marla for a period of 40 years, further extendable as per rules after due approval by the competent authority, subject to following conditions:

- A committee headed by Assistant Commissioner, Revenue(ACR)/Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) concerned and Tehsildar, Sub-Divisional Police Officer (SDPO), Block Development Officer (BDO), Executive Engineer concerned as members shall conduct thorough enquiry of the affected families whose houses have been damaged due to any of the Natural Calamity (floods, landslide, cloudbursts, earthquakes) that occurred during August / September 2025 and shall have become landless/Houseless due to these Natural Calamity and prepare a certified list of all eligible families. The list shall be vetted by the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
- The affected families are properly enumerated, verified and duly certified (as per the Revenue Records) by the District Disaster Management Authority headed by Deputy Commissioner of the concerned District. The affected family shall be determined on the basis of revenue records duly verified by District Disaster Management Authority and in case of deceased, all the legal heirs shall jointly be considered as one family
- The District Disaster Management Authority shall verify that the land with or without the appurtenant residential structure which is claimed to have been damaged / washed away in recent natural calamity was in existence and owned by the affected family AND the affected family does not own any other proprietary land within the affected village AND due to this natural disaster/natural calamity the family has been rendered landless. The District Disaster Management Authority shall vet the final list of landless families rendered landless due to Natural Calamity that occurred during the month of August/September 2025.

- The vetted list shall be forwarded to Tehsildar concerned to identify suitable patch of state land, prepare its revenue papers alongwith site map/tatima, non-encumbrance certificate and submit cases alongwith copy of Ration card/any other relevant documents of the affected family to the ACR/SDM concerned within two weeks.
- ACR/SDM shall recommend the case alongwith all relevant documents to the Deputy Commissioner concerned for allotment within 07 days.
- Deputy Commissioner concerned shall cause the certified list of eligible beneficiaries alongwith proposed allotment to be placed in public domain to invite any objections within a period of 15 days.
- Deputy Commissioner concerned after examining the case and the objections received and further inquiry as deemed necessary shall finalize the list of eligible landless families who qualifies for allotment of 05 Marla of State Land and grant land for residential purposes to the affected families.
- The lessee shall use the land only for the purpose for which it is granted, any contravention shall terminate the lease and land shall be resumed to the Government without any compensation.
- Deputy Commissioner concerned shall execute the lease agreement with the lessee as per the Form-I annexed herewith and necessary mutation shall be attested by Tehsildar.
- Data base of all such leases shall also be maintained in the office of Tehsildars, ACR/SDM concerned and Deputy Commissioner which shall be submitted to the Govt. of J&K by Deputy Commissioner concerned through proper channel.
- This scheme of grant of state land on lease basis to such families rendered landless by the recent natural calamity / disasters shall be limited to domiciles of UT of J&K only.
- This scheme of grant of state land on lease basis to such families rendered landless by the recent natural calamity / disasters shall be limited to rural areas only.
- Only such affected family or all the legal heirs jointly shall be eligible who is/are already existing in the verified list of DDMA and is entitled to the ex-gratia relief or has received such relief under SDRF / NDRF norms.
- This order shall only be applicable in cases which were affected by the natural calamity / disaster between 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2025 to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2025. The application for grant of land should be made **by or before 31<sup>st</sup> of March, 2026** before the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
- The District Administration shall identify the land for residential purpose in the same village or if not available, then in adjoining village and the identified land should be in safer location and not in recurring calamity zone/ landslides prone area/flood prone area etc. The land shall be used only for the residential purpose. Any contravention shall result in resumption of land by the Government without any compensation.
- The lessees shall not in any way transfer the land without the previous sanction of the government except for the simple mortgage of the lease hold rights of the leased land to secure loans from the banks / financial institutions.
- In case of death of lessee, all his lawful heirs/successors shall be entitled to succeed to the leased premises.

- The land obtained on the false claim/information/representation shall be deemed to be cancelled ab-initio
- The process of distribution of land in favour of the affected eligible families shall be in order of preference which is suggestive but not binding as:
  - PMAY beneficiaries those who are eligible as per duly verified list of RDD
  - PHH as per Ration Card
  - NPHH as per Ration card
  - AAY families as per ration card
- The eligible lessee shall be the person in whose name the washed away land existed as per revenue record (Explanation: If the person in whose name the land was recorded as per revenue record is deceased, then all the legal heirs shall be the co-lessees AND the quantum of land allotted jointly in favour of the co-lessees shall be limited to 5 marlas).
- The lease agreement shall be executed and signed with the concerned beneficiary/lessee by the respective Deputy Commissioner on behalf of the Government of Jammu and Kashmir.
