DHJ reviews implementation of departmental schemes





Marketing - cum - Processing Society Ltd. (U) 5 KM Talwara Milestone, Nr. Mukerian Hydel Power House No.1, G. T. Road, Talwara, Distt Hoshiarpur, Punjab - 144216
Whereas Food Analyst, National Food Laboratory Ghaziabad declared sample of said **aasnaa Jaggery Powder** as unsafe under section 3(1)(zz)(viii),(xi) and misbranded under section 3(1)(zf)(B)(ii) of FSS Act, 2006. vide his report no. JK-656/DEC/25/781 dated 03-12-2025
Whereas the sale of **aasnaa Jaggery Powder** is prohibited under Regulation 2.3.7 of Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restrictions on sales) Regulations 2011.
Now in exercise of powers conferred under section 36(3) (b) of Food Safety and Standards Act 2006 to the Designated Officer Food Safety, the sale of above said **aasnaa Jaggery Powder** is hereby **prohibited** in District Rajouri with immediate effect in the interest of general public health.
