- Bids must be accompanied with cost of Tender document in shape of e-challan through Treasury indicating Treasury Voucher No. & date, e-NIT No. and name of work duly crediting to 0059 (Revenue) favoring Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division, Bhaderwah uploading a copy of treasury challan and EMD/Bid Security in the shape of CDR/FDR duly pledged to Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division, Bhaderwah as mentioned in the bid documents (The Date of Treasury Challan should be between the date of Start of Bid and Bid Submission end Date)The earnest money of the unsuccessful bidder shall be released only after submission of Treasury Challan.
 - The electronic bidding system would not allow any late submission of bids after due date and time as per server time. Bidders may modify their bids by uploading their request for modification before the deadline for submission of bids. For this, the bidder need not make any additional payment towards the cost of tender document. For bid modification and consequential re-submission, the bidder is not required to withdraw his bid submitted earlier. The last modified bid submitted by the bidder within the bid submission time shall be considered as the bid. For this purpose, modification / withdrawal by other means will not be accepted. In online system of bid submission, the modification and consequential submission of bids is allowed any number of times. The bidders may withdraw his bid by uploading their request before the deadline for submission of bids; however, if the bid is withdrawn, the resubmission of the bid is not allowed. No bid shall be modified or withdrawn after the deadline of submission of bids.
 - The date and time of opening of Financial-Bids shall be notified on Web Site www.jktenders.gov.in and conveyed to the bidders automatically through an e-mail message on their e-mail address. The Financial-bids of Responsive bidders shall be opened online in the Office of Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division Bhaderwah. The date for same shall be intimated separately.
 - The bids for the work shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of Technical bids.

Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in Livestock

(FOR ATTENTION OF LIVESTOCK FARMERS)

Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) is a highly contagious viral disease affecting cattle, buffaloes, sheep, goats and pigs which spreads rapidly and causes heavy economic losses to dairy farmers due to reduction in milk yield, poor growth rate, reduced working capacity in bullocks and mortality in young animals.

Common Signs of FMD:

FMD is characterized by high fever (104-106° F), loss of appetite and dullness, vesicular eruptions in the mouth, nose, muzzle, interdigital space of hooves and udder that ulcerate resulting in excessive salivation, lameness and mastitis in affected animals. Incidence of abortion in pregnant animals and death in younger animals is also quite high in this disease.

How FMD spreads:

- ❖ Sharing of contaminated feed and water.
- ❖ Close contact with infected animal
- ❖ Through animal movement
- ❖ Through aerosol
- ❖ Through contaminated objects such as animal bedding etc.

Preventive & Control Measures:

- If the disease is suspected please report immediately to the local veterinary authorities.
- Segregation of affected animals from healthy ones in all respects including feeding and watering.
- Control over animal movement in affected areas to reduce the spread of virus.
- Control over movement of visitors and vehicles to livestock sheds.
- Infected animal sheds, equipment and premises to be cleaned with suitable disinfectant.
- Disposal of dead animals and infected feed and fodder should be carried out properly.
- Treatment is only symptomatic so contact your local veterinarian for suitable treatment.

Government Appeal:

Early reporting and timely vaccinations can save the animals and prevent the spread of this dreadful disease. Animal Husbandry Department Jammu has launched Phase-7 of Foot and Mouth Disease under National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) with effect from 2nd January, 2026 for mass vaccinations of cattle and buffalo population across all ten districts of Jammu province. The department urges livestock farmers to get their livestock vaccinated during the ongoing 45 days-long campaign.
