PATHANKOT: The Punjab Police on Saturday recovered a cache of arms and ammunition, including three AK 47 rifles, in the border area of Narot Jaimal Singh here, a senior police officer said.

Pakistan-based terrorist Harvinder Singh Rinda was behind sending the consignment of weapons to carry out sensational crime. Deputy IGP (Border Range) Sandeep Goel said police conducted a search operation in the Narot Jaimal Singh area after getting secret information about the weapons. A team of the Pathankot police found weapons comprising three AK 47 rifles, five magazines, two pistols -- a Turkey made and another made in China -- and 98 live cartridges of different calibre.
