Public intoxication offender sentenced to community service

JAMMU: In a landmark order under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), Jammu Police at Police Post Jourian secured the conviction of one accused involved in a case of public intoxication and disorderly conduct.

The accused has been identified as Baljinder Singh S/o Balkar Singh R/o Jadh Tehsil Jourian.

On 30-12-2025, accused was found intoxicated and creating nuisance in a public place within the jurisdiction of Police Post Jourian. He was arrested on the spot, medically examined, and subsequently produced before the Hon'ble Court of JMJC Akhnoor.

On 31-12-2025, the Court, adopting a reformative approach under Section 355 BNS, sentenced the accused to 07 days of community service at the Court Complex, Akhnoor, from 01-01-2026 to 07-01-2026.

Udhampur Police strikes against Narcos Mafia, 222 Arrested, Drugs Worth Rs 10.50 Cr Seized, assets Worth Rs 21 Cr Attached

Udhampur: During the year 2025, Udhampur Police intensified its drive against drug trafficking under Nasha Mukt Abhiyan. From January to December 2025, 153 NDPS cases were registered, leading to the arrest of 203 drug smugglers. 19 hardcore narcotics smugglers were booked under PIT NDPS.

In the crackdown, 77 vehicles were seized and 12 pharmacy shops were sealed for H1 drug violations. Narcotic substances worth ₹10.50 crore were seized, including heroin, charas, poppy straw and ganja. Illicit opium cultivation over 02 kanal and 10 marlas of land was also destroyed in Panchari.

Udhampur Police warns that drug peddlers will face strict legal action, including property attachment and financial seizure, as the campaign against narcotics continues with zero tolerance.

Upon questioning, the individual disclosed his identity as Sunny Kumar S/o Des Raj R/o Omara Morh, PTC, Udhampur. During his personal search, 5.30 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession.

Accordingly, FIR No. 02/2026 under Sections 8/21/22 of the NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Rehambal. The accused has been taken into custody and further investigation is underway.
