## Police arrests two drug peddlers; contraband recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing its sustained efforts to curb the menace of drug trafficking, Police in Budgam have arrested two drug peddlers and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

A police team from Police Station Budgam, during patrolling in village Karipora near the Railway Crossing, two intercepted suspicious persons. On seeing the police party, they attempted to flee but were promptly apprehended. They have been identified as Zahoor Ahmad Bhat son of Ghulam Qadir Bhat resident of Ompora, Budgam, and Amir Ahmad Gojri son of Ghulam Mohammad Gojri resident of Mohanpora, Budgam. During search, charas-like substances weighing approximately 47.38 grams was recovered from their possession. One mobile phone was also seized.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 347/2025 under relevant sections of law has been registered at Police Station Budgam, and investigation has been initiated.

## Two drug peddlers arrested with Heroin

UDHAMPUR/ THANANAMANDI: Polic eon Thursday nabbed two narco smugglers with heroin in separate cases.

During routine traffic checking, a naka party at naka Point Tikri noticed a suspicious individual moving on foot from Manthal side towards Tikri side. On spotting the naka, the person attempted to retreat but was swiftly apprehended by the police naka party.

Upon questioning, the individual disclosed his identity as Sunny Kumar S/o Des Raj R/o Omara Morh, PTC, Udhampur. During his personal search, 5.30 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession.

Accordingly, FIR No. 02/2026 under Sections 8/21/22 of the NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Rehambal. The accused has been taken into custody and further investigation is underway.



Meanwhile, During patrolling at Shahdra Sharief road, a team of PS Thananandi apprehended one person namely Mohd. Iqbal S/O Mushtaq Ahmed Mir R/o Ward No. 3, Majoor Rajdhani and recovered 7.80 grams of heroin from his possession. This arrest is a big achievement for district Police as the accused is a notorious drug peddler and had been evading arrest for a long time. He is alleged to be involved in supplying drugs, particularly targeting college students and local youth, thereby posing a serious threat to society.

In this connection, FIR No. 01/2026 under sections 8/21/22 of the NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Thanamandi.

Further investigation is underway to ascertain the source of the contraband and to identify other persons involved in this illegal trade.

## Bootlegger nabbed with 31 bottles of illicit liquor, cash Rs 1. 18 lakh

JAMMU: In a landmark order under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), Jammu Police at Police Post Jourian secured the conviction of one accused involved in a case of public intoxication and disorderly conduct.

The accused has been identified as Baljinder Singh S/o Balkar Singh R/o Jadh Tehsil Jourian .

On 30-12-2025, accused was found intoxicated and creating nuisance in a public place within the jurisdiction of Police Post Jourian. He was arrested on the spot, medically examined, and subsequently produced before the Hon'ble Court of JMIC Akhnoor.

On 31-12-2025, the Court, adopting a reformatory approach under Section 355 BNS, sentenced the accused to 07 days of community service at the Court Complex, Akhnoor, from 01-01-2026 to 07-01-2026.

TRAFFIC POLICE ADVISORY FOR 3<sup>rd</sup> JANUARY 2026.

On the eve of Birth Anniversary of Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji Maharaj on 5<sup>th</sup> January. 2026 (Monday), a Nagar Kirtan (Religious Procession) will be taken out on 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2026 (Saturday) from 0930 hours onwards. The procession will pass through the following route: -

Gurudwara Bibi Chand Kour – Swami Vivekananda Chowk – Gumat Crossing – J.P Chowk (Petrol Pump), Dogra Chowk – Bikram Chowk – Asia Hotel – Green Belt Park Gandhi Nagar – Govt. Hospital Gandhi Nagar Road – Cole Market – Bank of Baroda Chowk – Sachdeva Boutique – Balmiki Chowk – Shivaji Chowk – Khalsa Chowk and will culminate at Gurudwara Sri Guru Singh Sabha, Guru Nanak Nagar Jammu around 1700 hours.

In order to ensure smooth movement of traffic during the movement of procession. the following traffic diversions/ restriction shall be made enroute: -

**DIVERSIONS/ RESTRICTIONS DURING NAGAR KIRTAN :-**

1. All type of Heavy Vehicles bound for Katra, Udhampur, Doda, Srinagar will be diverted from Kunjwani till culmination of Nagar Kirtan.
2. The vehicles coming from Samba, Kathua and Inter-State vehicles bound for Udhampur/ Reasi shall adopt the route from Kunjwani via Narwal by pass towards Nagrota and onwards. Similarly, the vehicles coming from Katra- Udhampur axis bound for Samba, Kathua shall be diverted from TCP Nagrota via Sidhra bye pass towards Kunjwani and onwards.
3. The vehicles coming from Poonch, Rajouri, Akhnoor bound for Samba/ Kathua shall adopt Ring Road from Baba Talab Akhnoor Road Jammu for their convenient movement.

**FOR JAMMU CITY BOUND TRAFFIC:-**

1. The vehicles which are bound for Jammu City / Akhnoor can take the following two routes: -
  - a. Narwal – Qasim Nagar – PHQ Chowk – Bikram Chowk and Flyover.
  - b. Qasim Nagar – Gujjar Nagar Bridge – Circular Road.
2. The vehicles originating in between Kunjwani – Satwari and R.S Pura side.
  - a. The Heavy vehicles shall take diversion from Satwari Chowk and shall adopt Beli Charan Road for their convenient movement.
  - b. LMVs shall come upto Asia Crossing and will adopt 4<sup>th</sup> Tawi Bridge for further journey.
3. The flyover will remain operational for the whole day with the condition that when the tail of the Procession reaches at Bikram Chowk. The general public can follow routes during the movement of procession: -
  - a. The vehicles bound for NHW will follow the Bikram Chowk – Qasim Nagar Kunjwani.
  - b. The vehicles bound for Kunjwani will take Vigilance rotary – Flyover to Satwari for onward journey.
  - c. No vehicle will be allowed to use interior lanes of Gandhi Nagar and Shastri Nagar/ Nanak Nagar when head of the procession reach Bikram Chowk.
4. All types of vehicular movement on the route of the procession shall be restricted/ diverted depending upon the movement/ location of Nagar Kirtan.
5. When the procession will reach Gandhi Nagar, the vehicles coming from Shastri Nagar bound for Dogra Chowk shall be diverted via Last Morh to touch main road (Satwari – Bikram Chowk Road) during the movement of Nagar Kirtan.
6. The vehicles coming from Indira Chowk bound for J.P Chowk / Vivekananda Chowk shall be diverted towards Fly over or B.C road / 4<sup>th</sup> Tawi Bridge Bhagwati as per the on-ground situation till the procession crosses Dogra Chowk.

❖ People are advised to use Gujjar Nagar Bridge/ 4<sup>th</sup> Tawi Bridge/ Sidhra Bridge for their convenient movement from City North to City South and vice versa during the movement of Nagar Kirtan procession.

❖ There will be no entry of trucks in City Jammu from 0800 hours to 2000 hours.

General Public is requested to cooperate with Traffic Police for ensuring smooth conduct of the event and better traffic regulation.
