

LGEU raises concerns over accommodation allotment

JAMMU: The Lower Grade Employees Union, Civil Secretariat, Jammu & Kashmir, today held an emergency meeting to deliberate upon pressing issues concerning the alleged arbitrary allotment of Government accommodation by the Estates Department, Jammu, and the deteriorating hygienic conditions prevailing in the Civil Secretariat and Government Colonies.

The Union expressed grave concern over the recent allotment orders issued by the Estates Department, stating that not a single unit of Government accommodation had been allotted to members of the lower grade cadre. The Union termed this exclusion as unjust, discriminatory and demoralising, particularly as lower grade employees constitute an indispensable segment of the government workforce. Given their limited financial capacity and the rising cost of private accommodation, the Union asserted that lower grade employees deserve priority consideration in Government housing as a welfare measure. However, the recent allotments, the Union alleged, appear to have been carried out in a non-transparent and arbitrary manner, completely sidelining this category.

The meeting also highlighted the state of sanitation and hygiene in the Civil Secretariat and Government Colonies. The Union pointed out that drinking water quality is reportedly unsafe, cleaning and sanitation work remains grossly inadequate, and the sanitation tender expired more than a year ago without any clear decision regarding its renewal or re-tendering. As a consequence, hygienic conditions have deteriorated sharply, posing serious health risks to employees and residents. The Union further alleged that repeated representations to concerned Estates Officers, including Sandeep Salathia and Daljeet Singh Bal, failed to elicit effective action. According to the Union, the officers cited work pressure and inability to focus on sanitation-related issues, reflecting a lack of accountability that has aggravated the situation.

Serious concern was also expressed over the role of senior Estates officials. The Union alleged that the Deputy Director Estates, Jammu, in coordination with the Director Estates, J&K, and the Assistant Director Estates (Jammu), has adopted an exclusionary approach, ignoring the genuine claims of lower grade employees who contribute significantly to government functioning. Such actions, the Union stated, undermine fairness, inclusivity and employee morale. In view of the situation, the Union unanimously resolved to seek the unilateral intervention of the CM and the CS.

1. Ld. APP for UT of J&K present Accused absent and did not appear before the Court till date.
 2. An application has been made under section 87 of CrPC before this Court that Kapil Singh S/o Sandal Singh R/o H. No. 500, Shiv Nagar who has committed offences punishable under section of 382, 323 RPC and has absconded and warrant under section 512 CrPC has already been issued against him, whereas it has been shown that the said Kapil Singh has absconded and is concealing himself to avoid the execution of the said warrant. Therefore, proclamation was made that the said Kapil Singh is required to appear before this Court within 07 days of publication of this proclamation. However, despite proclamation accused failed to appear before this Court.
 3. Ld. APP presented the compliance report in respect of the proclamation under section 82/83 CrPC read with 84 BNSS, issued by this Court. It is reported that the SHO P/S Bakshi Nagar, Jammu has issued the publication of proclamation in respect of absconding accused namely Kapil Singh S/o Sandal Singh R/o H. No. 500, Shiv Nagar, Jammu, in compliance to the order of this Court in daily news papers "Dainik Zinda Sach" dated 31.08.2023, whereby the accused was required to attend this Court on 04.09.2023.
 4. However, despite publication of proclamation, the accused namely Kapil Singh S/o Sandal Singh R/o H. No. 500, Shiv Nagar, Jammu, has failed to appear before this Court till date. As such, his absence seems to be intentional and deliberate. So, the accused Kapil Singh is declared proclaimed Offender.
 5. In view of the situation that the accused has chosen not to appear in this trial court despite wide publication of proclamation notice for appearance, and is avoiding the trial intentionally and deliberately, as such, SHO P/S Bakshi Nagar, Jammu is directed to furnish the list of movable and immovable properties of accused Kapil Singh S/o Sandal Singh R/o H. No. 500, Shiv Nagar, Jammu, so that Court can proceed further with attachment of same.
 6. Office is directed to forward a copy each of this order to SHO P/S Bakshi Nagar, Jammu for compliance, and Manager, J&K Government Press, for publication in Government Gazette.
 7. Put up for further proceedings on 10.07.2025.
