

Army conducts medical camp under Op Sadbhavana near LoC

Whereas, the Department forwarded a note for agenda to J&K Public Service Commission for conducting Departmental Promotion Committee for confirmation/ regularization the service of these 07 officers against the post of Geologist Grade-I, and;

Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission regularized the services of 06 officers against the post of Geologist Grade-I. However, the J&K PSC/DPC has kept reserved the slot in favour of Dr Brijesh Kumar Manhas due to pendency of Regular Departmental Action (RDA) against him as he was involved in case No. JSC/DKR-12/2019, and;

Whereas, the Departmental Action initiated against the Officer was examined in the Department and on the basis of Inquiry report put forth by the Inquiry Officer, the same was closed at the Departmental level vide Government Order No. 24-JK(MNG) of 2023 dated 02.06.2023 thereby the officer exonerated from all the charges leveled against him and the Agenda Note for regularization/confirmation of the officer was again taken up with the J&K PSC/DPC, and;

Whereas, on the recommendation of the J&K Public Service Commission conveyed vide letter No. JK PSC/DPS/38/2025-05 dated 01.01.2026, the services of the officer is regularized/confirmed against the post of Geologist Grade-I, respectively w.e.f. 27.07.2021, and;

Whereas, in view of the regularization/confirmation of Dr. Brijesh Kumar Manhas, Geologist Grade-I, respectively w.e.f. 27.07.2021, his seniority is required to be fixed at S.No. 02 in the Final Seniority List of Geologist Grade-I as it stood on 01.01.2025 issued vide Government Order No. 55-JK(MNG) of 2025 dated 29.07.2025.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Clause-3 of Jammu and Kashmir Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme, 2022 notified vide S.O. 429 dated 6th September, 2022 read with S.O. 397 dated 16th of August 2024, sanction is, hereby, accorded to the appointment of Mohd Iqbal S/O Late Nazir Ahmad R/O Khara Madhana Tehsil Bari Brahmana District Samba of J&K, as MTS in Government Medical College Jammu in the Pay Level SL-1 (14800-47100).

The appointee shall report to the Principal Government Medical College Jammu within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order, failing which he shall forego his right to appointment and the same shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.

The appointee shall be allowed to join only on the production of the following certificates (in original) to be verified subsequently:-

- Academic Qualification Certificates.
- Date of Birth Certificate
- Health Certificate from the concerned Chief Medical Officer of the District.
- Domicile Certificate
- All other relevant documents as are required under the J&K Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme-2022.

The appointment of the appointee shall further be subject to the following conditions:-

- The applicant shall give an undertaking in writing as per format prescribed in the Scheme that he shall maintain properly the other family members who were dependent on the deceased and in case, it is proved subsequently, at any time that the family members are being neglected or are not being maintained properly his appointment shall be terminated forthwith.
- Any claim for transfer of appointment to any other family member shall invariably be rejected.
- The appointee shall be adjusted against appropriate category to which he belongs. In case the appointee fails to produce any valid category certificate, he shall be adjusted against General category.
- That he shall give an undertaking in the shape of an Affidavit to the effect that if on verification, his Qualification/Date of Birth/Category Certificates, if any, from the concerned issuing authority are found to be fake/forged, the claim of the appointee for appointment as Class- IV/Multitasking Staff (MTS) shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio and legal action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against him.
- That he shall give an undertaking in the shape of an Affidavit duly attested by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, to the effect that the applicant is unemployed as on date and none of the family members other than the applicant has taken benefit of compassionate appointment under J&K Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme-2022. In case, it turns out that the applicant is already appointed or the benefit of compassionate appointment under the Scheme has already been extended to the family of the deceased, then the instant appointment shall be deemed to have been withdrawn ab-initio without any further notice.
- That if the candidate has taken loan for self-employment from District Industries Centre (DIC)/Employment Department, to be ascertained from the DIC and District Employment & Counselling Centre of the domicile District, he shall relinquish the proprietorship of unit/enterprise and stakes, if any, in such self-employment unit/enterprise before joining the Government service. He shall be required to repay the entire loan liability in suitable EMIs to be worked out by the DDO concerned from his salary. The DDO concerned shall obtain an affidavit from the concerned appointee regarding both relinquishment of proprietorship and stakes, if any, in such self-employment unit/enterprise and recovery to be made and personally monitor its recovery.
- The salary of the appointee shall not be drawn and disbursed to him unless a satisfactory report in respect of genuineness of Qualification/Date of Birth/Category Certificate, if any, is received from the concerned authorities.
- The appointee shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- The appointment of the candidate shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as notified vide SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.
