

### KIWG 2026: Ladakh win first gold in women's short-track relay, skater Sachin keeps Haryana on top

LEH: Hosts Ladakh celebrated a landmark moment at the Khelo India Winter Games (KIWG) 2026 on Saturday as they clinched their first gold medal of the Games, winning the women's 2000 metres short-track relay at the Nawang Dorjay Stobdan (NDS) Stadium here. While Ladakh's triumph thrilled the home crowd, Haryana continued to dominate the medal tally, adding two more gold medals in short-track skating to lead overall with four golds. Ladakh's women's relay quartet of Skarma Tsultim, Shabana Zara, Tasnia Shameem and Insha Fatima delivered a determined performance in a dramatic final that saw several flips and crashes. Despite suffering falls themselves, the hosts regrouped strongly to outpace Karnataka and Maharashtra, the only other teams to qualify for the final. The gold medal propelled Ladakh to second place in the overall standings, underlining the region's growing presence in winter sports. Haryana's Sachin Singh emerged as the star of the day, becoming the first skater at KIWG 2026 to win two gold medals. The 26-year-old first captured the men's 500m short-track sprint and later anchored Haryana to victory in the men's 3000m short-track relay, finishing ahead of Karnataka and Himachal Pradesh. "This is the first time I've won a national-level gold medal, and I'm proud to represent Haryana," Sachin said, crediting his coach, managers and the Haryana association for their support. Sachin trains at the Youngsters Academy in Dehradun.

Telangana's Nayana Sri Talluri once again proved her dominance in the women's 500m short track, claiming her first gold of KIWG 2026 on her fourth consecutive gold in the event. The 17-year-old, who now trains in Canada, flew into Leh specifically for the Games. "Winning again feels wonderful. The competition was very tough, which makes this gold even more special," Nayana said after her victory.

In Saturday's finals, Sachin Singh clocked 46.14 seconds to win the men's 500m, while Nayana finished the women's race in 50.49 seconds. Haryana's men's relay team won gold with a timing of 5:16.96, and Ladakh's women's relay team topped the podium with 3:49.23 seconds.

In ice hockey action, Chandigarh secured the women's bronze medal by defeating Himachal Pradesh 4-3 in extra time. With thrilling contests and strong local performances, the Khelo India Winter Games 2026 continue to gather momentum in Leh.
