**JAMMU:** Army's Western Commander Lt Gen Manoj Kumar Katiyar on Wednesday visited Kathua district of Jammu and Kashmir and congratulated the troops who had eliminated a dreaded Pakistani terrorist in an encounter last week.  
 The army commander was briefed by the brigade commander on plans for continued domination of the area, the Western Command said in a post on X.  
 "Lt Gen Katiyar visited the Bani-Macheli sector, Kathua and congratulated Sep XXX of the SIKH LI Regiment who had eliminated a dreaded JeM terrorist in a close encounter, risking his own life. He compli-
