ORDER

1) Incharge APP present Accused No. 1 is present along with counsel. Accused No. 2 is absent. Non-bailable warrant issued against accused no. 2 on previous date received back with report with accused no. 2 is the resident of Pathankote Punjab due to which SHO is not able to execute the warrant and they make request before the court to writ higher officials of police regarding execution of warrant. This is not the mandate for the execution of non-bailable warrant. Rather it is very lackadaisical approach on the part of police regarding execution of warrant. (Copy of non-bailable warrant dated: 13.10.2025 annexed).

2) From the perusal of record it transpires that the accused no. 2 is absconding and concealing himself so as to prevent execution of warrant and I am satisfied that proceedings for compelling appearance of accused no. 2 including proclamation is required to be invoked against accused no. 2. In order to expedite the trial SHO Katra is directed to publish the proclamation containing in Para No. 2 comprising (i) to (iv) on his permanent address mentioned in the challan bby or before 10.12.2025 and then file is kept for appearance of accused no. 2 on 07.01.2026.

3) SHO Katra shall get the proclamation published as follows:-
 (i) It shall be publically read in some conspicuous place of the town i.e on address as provided in the charge-sheet.
 (ii) It shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the house or home stead in which accused person is ordinarily resides i.e as provided in the charge-sheet.
 (iii) A copy of thereof shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of Court i.e Notice Board of this Court.
 (iv) SHO Katra is further directed to get is published in a daily newspapers (both English and Hindi edition) which are having circulation in the area where accused ordinarily resides.

4) SHO Katra shall furnish photographs evidencing the police officials that proclamation is read in conspicuous place and while affixing the proclamation as per direction (i) and (ii) above and he is further directed to ensure the compliance and submit report and shall ensure that proclamation be published in the above mentioned newspaper by next date i.e 10.12.2025 and furnish both the newspapers as a whole and not only the cutting in which proclamation is published.

5) Office is directed to issue fresh NBW of arrest against accused No. 2 simultaneously as issued under para 1 of this order which shall remain in force until cancelled by this Court and SHO Katra is again authorized to arrest the accused no. 2 anywhere in India after conducting inquiry of his whereabouts.

TRAFFIC POLICE ADVISORY FOR BEATING RETREAT CEREMONY ON 29.01.2026.

The Beating Retreat Ceremony will be held at M.A Stadium Jammu on 29th January-2026. The Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Union Territory Jammu & Kashmir will take the salute at M.A Stadium and large number of VIPs/ Senior Officers/ guests/ spectators/ School Children are expected to witness the beating retreat ceremony at the Venue. In order to ensure smooth movement of general public the general public especially the motorists are requested to follow the traffic police advisory as mentioned below:-

PARKING SLOTS FOR PASS HOLDERS:-

- All the pass holders shall enter to their respective parking slots issued to them by Civil Administration and get their vehicle parked accordingly in the allotted parking Slot.
- Car passes shall be pasted on the left side of front windscreen of the vehicles to get entry as per the allotted parking pass on first come first serve basis.
- No other parking slot /short cut approach towards the allotted parking slot shall be allowed to avoid last moment confusion.

BAND CONTINGENTS /CULTURAL PARTICIPANTS PARKING	G.G.M. SCIENCE COLLEGE PARKINGS
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- All vehicles carrying contingents/Participants coming from Akhnoor and Talab Tillo side, will turn towards Commerce College, old University Lane and shall enter from the rear gate of Science College and park their vehicles near Boys Hostel GGM Science College.
- Other such vehicles coming from South side will take Dogra Chowk, Jewel Chowk take turn towards Commerce College, Old University lane and shall enter from the rear gate of Science College and park their vehicles Boys Hostel GGM Science College.
- Vehicles carrying contingents/ Participants coming from City North shall also be diverted via Maheshpora / Jewel towards Commerce College from where they shall be using Old Univ. Lane to reach Boys Hostel GGM Science College.

ARMY / PARA MILITARY VEHICLES CARRYING FAMILIES AT OLD UNIVERSITY CAMPUS via CANAL ROAD
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- All army vehicles coming from Bikram Chowk (South side) shall adopt Tawi Bridge to reach Dogra Chowk-Jewel Chowk Science college road and shall park their vehicle inside old University campus in systematic manner.

Subject: Integration of Migrant Ration Cards into the National Food Security Act (NFSA) Database.

PUBLIC NOTICE

It is for the information of public in general and the migrants registered with the Relief Organization (M), J&K, in particular that it has come to the notice of this office that some mischievous elements are spreading disinformation on social media regarding integration of migrant ration cards on National Food Security Act(NFSA) database.

It has already been clarified through a series of public notices, published after issuance of Government notifications vide S.O. 392 and S.O. 393, both dated 13.08.2024, wherein, the necessary amendments in the Jammu and Kashmir Food Security Rules,2021 and Targeted Public Distribution(Control) Order 2023, have been done to enable migrants to avail the benefit of various Government Schemes, that these amendments will not affect migrant status and extant scale of ration distribution. Further, in terms of the Government Order No 27-JK(DMRRR) of 2025 dated 16.05.2025, it has also been explicitly clarified that the existing scale of ration distribution to the migrants registered under the Relief Category and norms/procedures for Inclusion, Deletion, Bifurcation, Conversion, Corrections of Ration Cards shall continue.

Through the medium of this notice the public in general and Kashmiri/Jammu migrants registered with Relief Organisation in particular are advised not to pay any heed to the rumours being spread in the social media. All the registered migrants, particularly those registered under Relief Category are requested to complete the enrolment/eKYC formalities **by 16th February 2026**, to continue to avail hassle free relief benefits, including free ration and benefits under various social sector schemes, as per the eligibility.
