

LIC offers excellent opportunity for revival of Lapsed Policies

MUMBAI: The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has introduced an excellent opportunity for policyholders to revive their lapsed insurance policies by launching a Special Revival Campaign from January 1 to 2, 2026.

The campaign applies to individual lapsed policies and has been designed to assist policyholders who were unable to pay their premiums on time due to unfavourable circumstances.

Under this campaign, LIC is offering an attractive concession on late fees for all eligible Non-Linked Insurance Plans. A concession of up to 30 percent on the late fee is available, subject to a maximum limit depending on the total receivable premium. For policies with receivable premiums up to Rs 1,00,000, the maximum concession allowed is Rs 3,000. For pre-

miums between Rs 1,00,001 and Rs 3,00,000, the concession is capped at Rs 4,000, while policies with receivable premiums of Rs 3,00,001 and above are eligible for a maximum concession of Rs 5,000. In the case of Micro Insurance Plans, a full 100 percent concession on late fees is being offered. Terms and conditions apply.

As per the scheme guidelines, policies can be revived within five years from the date of the first unpaid premium, subject to fulfillment of the policy's terms and con-

ditions. Only those policies that are in a lapsed condition during the premium-paying term and have not completed the policy term are eligible for revival under this campaign. No concessions are available on medical or health requirements, wherever applicable.

LIC has stated that the Special Revival Campaign has been launched for the benefit of policyholders who could not pay premiums on time due to unavoidable or adverse circumstances. Policyholders are advised to

revive their lapsed policies and keep them in force in order to restore full insurance coverage and enjoy complete policy benefits.

LIC reiterated its commitment to valuing its policyholders and supporting their desire to remain financially protected.

The campaign offers a valuable opportunity for policyholders to revive their policies and ensure long-term financial security for their families and loved ones.
