

CRIME REPORT

4 drug peddlers arrested; psychotropic substance recovered

SOPORE: Continuing its efforts to curb menace of drugs from the society, Police on Friday arrested 4 drug peddlers in Sopore and recovered psychotropic substance from their possession.

As per details, acting swiftly on a reliable information about drug trade, a special team led by SHO Police Station Dangiwaacha under the supervision of SDPO Rafiabad established a checkpoint at Ladoora crossing and intercepted 4 persons, who were identified as Muhammad Ramzan Dar; son of Bashir Ah Dar; resident of Ladoora Rafiabad; Nazir Ah Sheikh, son of Muhammad Sultan Sheikh and Umer Yousuf, son of Mohd Yousuf Lone, both residents of Nadihal Rafiabad and Farooq Ahmad Ambar, son of Ghulam Nabi Ambar, resident of Tarzoo Amberpora. During checking, officers recovered 1,008 banned capsules from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to Police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 195/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Dangiwaacha and further investigation started.

Kidnapped minor girl rescued

REASI: Police on Friday rescued a kidnapped minor recovered within 48 hours of registration of complaint.

As per details, on December 7, 2021 a written complaint was lodged by father of the girl, resident of Chapra Talwara stating that his 15 years old daughter went to market for shopping but did not return back. On getting information, FIR no. 235/2021 under section 363 of IPC was lodged at Police Station Reasi.

Sensing gravity of crime SSP Reasi constituted a special team for tracing of minor. During the course of investigation, team started search of the girl and enquiry was made from family members, neighbours etc.

After getting a clue that girl has been kidnapped and is in Sumbhard area of Dharnkund, Ramban, a team was immediately sent to Ramban for recovery of the girl. After hectic efforts, Reasi Police recovered the girl from Sumbhard, Ramban. Taking the advantage of darkness, the accused managed to flee from the spot. Police is trying to trace and arrest accused at the earliest. After conducting medical examination of victim through board of doctors and completing other legal procedures, the girl was handed over to legal heirs.

Rs 31,600 fine recovered from COVID SoPs violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Friday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 31,600 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 71,63,500. The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 1146 persons were administered first and second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district on Friday. Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin

JAMMU: Police on Friday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered 8 gm heroin from his possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station City led by SHO City Insnr Vijay Kumar rounded up a suspect from a vehicle (JK04D-1355) coming towards Shalamar road, who turned suspicious on seeing police. On search, 8 gm heroin was recovered from his possession. The accused was identified as Saeed Nafees Hussain, son of Saeed Barket Hussain, resident of Gingal Tehsil, Uri. He was arrested and FIR No. 76/2021 under sections 8/21/22/25 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station City. The overall arrest and recovery in the case was made under the supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kalu.

6 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: To check menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy has been devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Station Nagrota, Police Posts Phallain Mandal, Sainik Colony, Sidhra and Talab Tillo acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 6 different vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a Dumper (JKCU 5811) and a tipper (JK02CS 4966) seized by Talab Tillo police; a tractor-trolley without registration number seized by Phallain Mandal police; a tractor-trolley bearing Engine no. CJ-1354/LD002577 seized by Sidhra police; a tipper (JK02CM 8864) seized by Sainik Colony police and a tipper (JK02AM 7538) seized by Nagrota police.

The overall recoveries were made by SHO Police Station Nagrota Insnr Vishav Pratap Singh, Incharge Police Post Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh, Incharge Police Post Sainik Colony PSI Mohd Younis Khanday and Incharge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Rajesh Kumar in their respective jurisdictions. DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same.

Two missing women among 4 traced; reunited with families

JAMMU/KATHUA: Police on Friday traced four missing persons including two women and a minor boy and handed them over to their families.

As per details, a missing report was lodged in Police Station Pacea Danga by father of a minor boy stating that his son went missing from Manda on December 6,2021. In this regard, FIR no 203/2021 under section 363 of IPC was registered and investigation started. On this, a team led by SHO Police Station Pacea Danga Insp Raghunbir Singh assisted by Incharge Police Post Panjirthri SI Ranjit Singh under supervision of SDPO City North Sharad Kalu, with strenuous efforts and help of technical assistance, finally succeeded in tracing the minor boy from Bus Stand, Jammu. Boy was handed over to his family members after completing all legal formalities.

Meanwhile, on July 24, 2020, a missing report was lodged at Police Station Kathua by a one Punjab Singh stating therein that his son namely Ramesh Singh, resident of Bagial Tehsil & District Kathua went missing. Accordingly, a missing report was lodged and search started to trace him. The Boy was traced and handed-over to family.

While in another instance, a missing report was lodged at Police Station Kathua in respect of Tanu Sumbaria, wife of Aslam, resident of Faizabad, Uttar Pradesh. The woman was successfully traced and handed-over to family members. Meanwhile in another instance, one missing report was lodged at Police Station Kathua in respect of Nisha Devi, wife of Prem Chand, resident of Barnoti Tehsil & District Kathua on August 29, 2021. She was also traced out and immediately handed over to legal heirs after completion of all legal formalities.

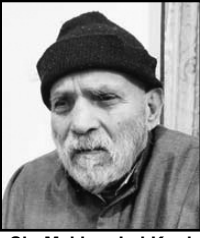
