J&K reports 182 new COVID cases

JAMMU: Jammu and Kashmir on Saturday reported 182 new Covid cases, 33 from the Jammu division and 149 from the Kashmir valley, thus taking the total number of positive cases in the Union Territory to 338745.

Also, one COVID death has been reported from Kashmir Division, officials said.

Meanwhile, Deputy Commissioner Jammu has declared Rajinder Nagar Sector-3 and the Greenfield Enclave in Gole Gujral in the Jammu City as micro-containment zones in view of detection of the infection

According to the daily Media Bulletin, out of 338745 positive cases, 1595 are Active Positive (418 in Jammu Division and 1177 in Kashmir Division), 332659 have recovered and 4491 have died; 2189 in Jammu division and 2302 in Kashmir division.

The Bulletin further said that out of 18220012 test results available, 338745 samples have tested positive and 17881267 samples have been tested as negative till date. Besides, 57,363 COVID tests have been conducted in last 24 hours.
