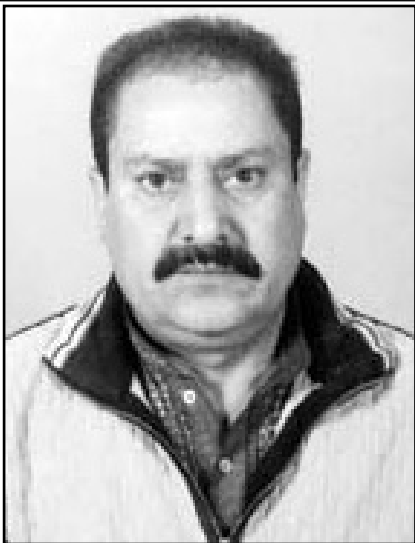

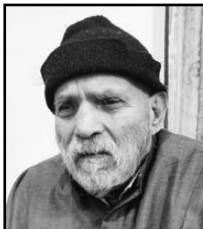

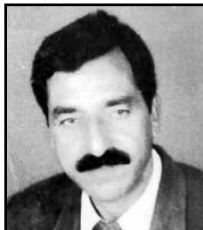

CRIME REPORT

Rs 25,300 fine recovered from SoPs violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Monday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 25,300 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 72,47,300.

The Enforcement officers urged people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 1031 persons were administered first and second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district on Monday. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr Mohammad Fared Bhat, the Health Department has collected 2,239 samples including 617 RT-PCR and 1,622 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 1,031 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

20 bovines rescued; smuggler held

KATHUA: In a bid to contain activities of bovine smugglers within the district, Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal foiled a bovine smuggling attempt within district by rescuing 20 bovines and arrested 1 smuggler on Monday.

As per details, a police team led by Insp Surinder Pal Singh SHO Lakhanpur under the supervision of DySP DAR Kathua Sukhdev Singh during Naka/checking duty in its jurisdictional area, noticed a suspicious vehicle (JK02CD-2627), being driven by one Sajad Choudhary, son of Mohd Sadiq, resident of Kolsaina, Tehsil Haveli. The vehicle was signaled to stop for checking and during checking, 17 bovines were found laden in it and concealed under the sacks of onions. Police has rescued 17 bovines and arrested the driver. FIR No 111/2021 under section 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Lakhanpur and further investigation was set into motion accordingly.

While in another instance, a team led by Insp Amit Sangra SHO Rajbagh under the supervision of SDPO Border Sachit Mahajan during patrolling duty at Khanpur noticed movement of suspicious Mahindra (PB35Q-9810) enroute Jammu. On way near Khanpur, it hit a pedestrian namely Parkash Chand, son of Ramsaran, resident of Khanpur Tehsil Marheen who got seriously injured and was shifted to GMC Kathua for treatment. During checking, police team recovered 3 bovines which were rescued. FIR No. 260/2021 under sections 188/279/337 of IPC and 11 of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Rajbagh in this regard.

Major crime incident averted, two arrested with pistol

JAMMU: Police on Monday averted a major crime incident by arresting two accused with a weapon.

As per details, a team of Police Station Satwari led by SHO Satwari Inspr Deepak Jasrotia assisted by PSI Darshan Singh while on patrolling duty near Airport Jammu found a Baleno (JK02CE-5360) parked on roadside in darkness. On this, police team enquired from persons sitting in vehicle on which they started shouting and assaulted police officials on duty, but were overpowered swiftly by police team. During search, a Chinese pistol along with magazine was recovered from their possession which they were carrying for committing some serious crime in area. Duo was arrested and FIR no 282/21 under sections 353/34 of IPC, 7/25 of Arms Act was registered against them at Police Station Satwari. The accused have been identified as Randeep Singh, son of Khushwant Singh, resident of Nanak Nagar, Jammu and Lohjot Singh, son of Inderjeet Singh, resident of Nanak Nagar, Jammu. The vehicle was also seized by police. The overall arrests and recovery was made under supervision of SDPO South P K Mengi.



Missing caterer still untraceable

JAMMU: A caterer who went missing since Sunday remained untraceable on Monday.

As per details, scooty of Vishal Gandhi, resident of Subhash Nagar was found near Tawi bridge at Bhagwati Nagar following which a search was started by his parents. They lodged a missing complaint with police, which recovered a suicide note, wallet and a mobile phone from dickey of scooty. During investigation, it was learnt that Vishal went to his friend Nishant for taking his money back who called him to Pounichak. Police has detained Nishant for questioning, who disclosed that he gave Rs 10,000 to Vishal when he came to him. But during search of wallet, police didn't find any money. However, family has also claimed that handwriting in suicide note not matches to that of Vishal.

House burgled at Nanak Nagar, car stolen from outside Meridian Palace

JAMMU: Thieves on Monday burgled a house in Nanak Nagar and decamped with cash and gold ornaments, however a car was also stolen from outside Meridian Palace.

As per details, Jagmeet Singh, Sec 10, Nanak Nagar lodged a complaint with police that thieves targeted his house when he was out for some work. He fur-

ther disclosed that thieves decamped with two gold sets, ear-rings and some cash. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

Meanwhile, thieves also stole a car parked outside Meridian Palace. Owner of car Amit Sharma, resident of Sugnu has lodged a complaint with police.

Man murdered in Qasim Nagar

The deceased has been identified as Mohd Farooq, son of Kalu, resident of Ramban. Marks of cut by sharp-edged weapons were found on his body. Police is investigating the matter.

Woman found hanging

42 employees found absent during surprise inspection
