Applications through online mode are invited from the applicants who are domiciled in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir and are possessing the prescribed Academic/Professional qualification and age for the following posts in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Classified) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979 (issued under SRO 517 dated 19.09.1979; Government Order No. 782-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 06.10.2020 (Super Specialty Jammu); Government Order No. 961-HME of 2019 dated 24.10.2019 (Super Specialty Srinagar) and the "Jammu & Kashmir Probationers (Conduct of Service, Pay & Allowance) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020" notified vide S.O. 192 of 2020 dated: 17.06.2020 read with The Jammu & Kashmir Public Service Commission (Business and Procedure) Rules, 2021:-

- > The Application Form(s) with instructions for filling up the Application Form(s) will be available at the website of the Commission from **20.12.2021**
- > Candidates are advised to go through the instructions and all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the post before filling the online Application Form.
- > Last date for filling of online Application complete in all respects along with the requisite fee (online mode only) is **19.01.2022**
- > The last date for receipt of online applications provided in the notification shall be the cut-off date for determining the eligibility as regards possession of Domestic Certificate and educational and professional qualifications.
- > The minimum and maximum age will be as mentioned with reference to **1st January, 2021**.
- > Candidates can edit some of the fields in their online application form from **22.01.2022 to 24.01.2022 (up to 11:59 PM)**. Instructions in this regard will be separately made available on the website.
- > Candidates are required to upload all the mandatory prescribed/requisite documents.
- > Candidates will not be required to submit a hard copy of the online application form and the mandatory prescribed/requisite documents.
- > In case the mandatory prescribed/requisite documents are not uploaded with the online application form, the application form/candidature of the applicant is liable to be rejected.
- > Candidates are advised in their own interest to submit online applications much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability to pay fee or failure to login to the online application portal on account of heavy load on the website during the closing days.

5. Reservation

- A candidate seeking higher consideration under any Reserved Category must ensure that he/she possesses a valid requisite Category certificate as on the cut-off date.
- The candidature of the candidates will be provisional till the genuineness of the reserved category certificate is verified by the Appointing Authority.
- Candidates may note that in case a claim for reservation is made on the basis of false/fake/inauthentic certificate, he/she shall be debarred from the examination(s) conducted by the J&K Public Service Commission, in addition to any other penal action as may be deemed appropriate.

6. Domicile

The candidate should be a Domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir. The candidate must possess a valid Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the prescribed format as on the last date prescribed for submission of online application form.

7. Requisite Fee

After successful submission of the online application form, candidate will be required to deposit requisite fee through online mode. The amount of fee to be paid is given below:-

Note:

- The application Form submitted without deposition of the fee, which gets substantiated through reflection of the same on the application form, such application form shall be treated as incomplete and candidature shall be deemed to have been rejected without any notice. No representation against such rejection shall be entertained.
- Submission of multiple applications by way of prefixing M/Ms or through generation of multiple User ID's or any other mode, followed by either non-payment of fee particulars or fee particulars (TID) of one application (RID) being mentioned against another application with a different RID would lead to rejection of the online application. The applicants who are submitting multiple applications should note that only the applications with higher Registration ID (RID) number shall be entertained by the Commission and fee paid against one RID shall not be adjusted against any other RID number. Besides a strict disciplinary action shall be taken including the cancellation of candidature and debarment for future examinations of J&K PSC will be taken against such applicants.

8. Documents to be uploaded

While filling the online application form the applicants are required to upload the documents as per details given below:-

- Certificate to the effect that DNB in the relevant Super Specialty has been done from a 500 bedded institution/ hospital or one year Senior Residency or equivalent experience, on prescribed format, from an institution/hospital duly recognized by the Medical Council of India, now National Medical Commission, (where applicant is applying for the Super Specialty post on the basis of DNB).

- Two years experience certificate from the teaching institutions recognized by the Medical Council of India (now National Medical Commission), as per format (except for the post of Lecturer in Super Specialty Hospital Jammu/Srinagar). 01 leaf

It may be noted that no further opportunity to upload any document shall be provided hereafter and action under rules including rejection of application form/candidature etc will be taken.

9. Scheme of Selection

Selection shall be made in accordance with the provisions laid down in the Jammu & Kashmir Public Service Commission's (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021 as amended from time to time.

Candidates are especially advised to apprise themselves with the provisions of Rule 44 of the Jammu & Kashmir Public Service Commission's (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021.

10. Important instructions regarding filling up of online applications are given herein below:-

- Candidates are required to apply online through the website of the Commission i.e. <http://www.jkpsc.co.in>. No other means/ mode of application shall be accepted.
- Candidates are first required to go to the JKPS website <http://www.jkpsc.co.in> and click on the link "One Time Registration" or click on Login menu if you have already created your profile with the JK PSC.
- After logging into your account, candidates are required to fill all the requisite fields of One Time Registration (OTR) i.e. personal information, contact information & educational qualification, service details etc.
- The candidate shall also be required to upload the image of date stamped recent passport size color photograph and signature. The photograph should not be taken earlier than 01.01.2021.
- Size of the photograph (passport size) and signature must be between 10kB to 20kB in *.jpg or *.png only.
- After successful submission of all the details in your OTR account, check the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the advertisement notification before applying for the post.
- Click on the "show examination" as shown against the respective post/examination you want to apply.
- On Clicking on the "show examination" a window will appear on your computer screen. Select the month of the advertisement notification for which you want to apply, a link(s) for the post(s) will appear on the computer screen.
- An "APPLY" button is shown against the respective post and the candidates will click on the APPLY button against the post he/she is eligible.
- On clicking "APPLY" button, an instruction window will appear. Candidates should read instructions carefully before clicking on "APPLY" button at the bottom of the webpage.
- On clicking "APPLY" button, the system will display all facts/particulars that a candidate may have mentioned while filling up the necessary fields of his/her OTR account. Candidate shall fill up the remaining required fields in the application form and accept the declaration thereof.
- Once the candidate is satisfied about the correctness of the filled in details, then, he or she may click on "SUBMIT" button to finally push the data into server with successful submission report.
- On successful submission of the basic details, the candidates will be required to pay the online fee and uploading of the documents, for final submission of the online application form.
- Candidates can pay the requisite fee through online mode in the "SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS" menu in your account.
- After successful payment of the fee, the fee status will get reflected on the Online Application form. Candidates can check the fee status by clicking on

xv. After successful payment of the fee, the fee status will get reflected on the Online Application form. Candidates can check the fee status by clicking on the **Paid Application Button** in the submitted Applications menu in your JKPS account. In case the payment status shows either "not submitted or under processing or status has not been reflected on your submitted application form", candidate(s) are advised to contact the JKPS office at Solina Srinagar/Resham Ghar Colony Jammu immediately for clarification. Further where the online fee is paid through other service providers the candidate must ensure that not only the amount of fee is debited from his/service provider's Account but also credited into the official account of JKPS.

xvi. The candidate would be able get the printout of his/her submitted application only after the payment of the requisite fee and uploading of mandatory prescribed/requisite documents.

xvii. The JKPS will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for the eligibility and other aspects at the time of filling up of online and therefore, candidature will be accepted only provisionally. The candidates are advised to go through the requirements of educational qualification, age, etc and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post(s). Copies of supporting documents will be sought at the time of document verification. When scrutiny is under taken, if any claim if made in the application is not found/substantiated by proof, the candidature will be cancelled and the Commission's decision shall be final and binding.

xviii. Please note that the above procedure is the only valid procedure for applying. No other mode of application or incomplete steps would be accepted and such applications would be rejected.

11. Editing of the online application form

Candidates who have successfully submitted the online application form along with requisite fee will be allowed to edit some of the fields in their submitted online application form within three days after the cut-off date i.e. on **22.01.2022 to 24.01.2022 (upto 11:59 PM)**. Detailed instruction in this regard will be made available on the website.

12. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct

Candidates are advised that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information.

A candidate who is, or has been, declared by the Commission, to be guilty of:

- obtaining by wrongful support of his/her candidature by any means, or
- impersonating, or
- procuring impersonation by any person, or
- submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with or
- making statements which are incorrect, or false or suppressing material information, or
- resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the selection, or
- attempting to commit or, as the case may be, abetting the Commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, shall be liable:

- to be disqualified by the Commission from selection for which he/she is a candidate, and/or
- to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period:-
 - By the Commission from any examination or selection held by them.
 - By the Union Territory Government from any employment under them, and,
 - if he/she is already in service under Government, disciplinary action can be taken against him/her under the appropriate rules.
