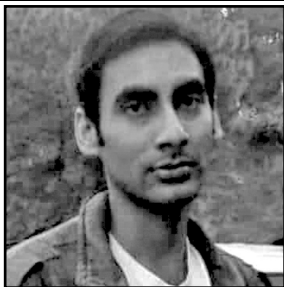

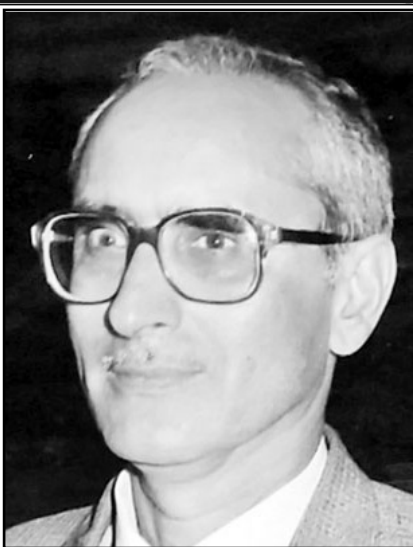

Man held with intoxicants

JAMMU: Police on Friday nabbed a man and recovered intoxicating capsules from his possession.

He was intercepted and during search 237 capsules of Spasmo-Proxyvon T + 25 Mg was recovered from his possession. Identified as Gourav, son of Puran Chand, resident of Chinore, near Govt Primary School Chinore, the accused was arrested and FIR No 214/2021 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Pacea Danga.

CRPF Jawan dies of cardiac arrest

He was immediately rushed to a nearby hospital, where doctors declared him brought dead.

Gang of bike-lifters busted; 3 arrested, 1 bike recovered

Hotel employee among two die under mysterious circumstances

5 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

KATHUA: Tightening noose over bovine smugglers within district, Kathua Police under the overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal on Friday rescued 5 bovines and seized a vehicle.

As per details, a team led by Insp Surinder Pal Singh, SHO Police Station Lakhampur while on patrolling/Naka checking duty at Magar Khad intercepted a vehicle (PB06AS-4629) coming from Punjab towards Jammu and signalled it to stop.

Sensing danger, driver of the vehicle parked his vehicle and managed to escape from spot. During checking of vehicle, 5 bovines were found loaded in the vehicle mercilessly which were rescued. On this, FIR No. 112/2021 under sections 188 of IPC and 11 of PCA Act was registered.

Missing woman traced, reunited with family

6 vehicles seized for illegal mining, two dumps of material recovered

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Stations Jhajar Kotli, R S Pura, Police Posts Pounichak and Phallain Mandal acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 6 different vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles included a tractor-trolley (JK20 2741) and a tipper (JK14A1729) seized by Jhajar Kotli police; a tractor-trolley without registration number by R S Pura police; 2 tractor-trolleys without Registration number seized by Pounichak police and a tractor-trolley without registration number by Phallain Mandal police.

The overall recoveries were made by SHO Jhajar Kotli Inspr Devinder Singh, SHO R S Pura Inspr Jaipal Sharma, Incharge Police Post Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria and Incharge Police Post Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal in their respective jurisdictions. On the other hand, acting stringently on an information, teams from Police Stations Miran Sahib and Bishnah raided suspected locations in their respective areas and seized two dumps of mining material.

A dump owned by Deepak Lal, son of Darbari Lal, resident of Raipur Jattan was seized by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Mirza Sultan whereas another dump and a JCB (JK02CH-0975) belonging to Ashwani Kumar, son of Babu Ram, resident of Bishnah was seized by Police Station Bishnah under supervision of SHO Bishnah Insp Joginder Singh.
