

Agri Deptt Jammu launches 2nd Crop Insurance Week celebrations

JAMMU: To mark the celebration of 2nd Crop Insurance / PMFBY Week under Bharat Ka Amrit Mahatsav-India@75 campaign, a function was held on Wednesday at Krishi Bhawan Jammu.

An Information Education and Communication (IEC) Van was flagged off by Director of Agriculture Production & Farmers Welfare K. K. Sharma.

The purpose of celebrating Crop Insurance Week is to spread mass awareness and ensure maximum enrolment of the farmers under the Insurance scheme during Rabi-2021-22.

The van campaign is being organized by IFFCO TOKIO Insurance Company in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Jammu under Pardhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna (PMFBY) to inform farmers about the PMFBY scheme.

Speaking on the occasion, the Director AP & FWD informed that this IEC

(Information, Education & communication) Van will cover all the 20 Blocks comprising 305 panchayats of District Jammu to promote Pardhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna (PMFBY) and its coverage among the farming community. Similar campaign is also being held in Samba and Udhampur Districts.

The Director said that the Department is striving hard to bring more and more farmers under Fasal Bima Yojna during the week w.e.f. 1st to 7th of December, 2021. He informed that 15th December is the last date to opt for crop insurance and stressed on coverage of loanee (KCC holders) as well as non loanee farmers under the scheme. He advised the non-loanee farmers to get them enrolled under the scheme through Common Facility Centres (CFCs).

He emphasized that the Fasal Bima Yojna will go a long way in mitigating the financial risk of the farmer suffering from the crop losses and aid in stabilizing the farmer's income. This will also

ensure flow of credit in the Agriculture Sector.

Besides others, Joint Director (SLUB/Farms), Rajinder Sharma; Joint Director (Inputs) A. S Reen; Joint Director (Agriculture & Mushroom Development),

Iqbal Singh; Joint Director (Marketing), Mahesh Verma; SDAO Marh, Ashwani Kumar Jojra and District Coordinator, IFFCO TOKIO (PMFBY) Jammu, Tahir Ishaq were also present on the occasion.

Whereas, the Government has launched Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Sehat Scheme to provide free of cost "Universal Health Coverage" to all the residents of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir; and

Whereas, in district Reasi about 82% families with at least one member have been registered against the target of 55438 families and about 1,56,337 individual beneficiaries have been registered under the scheme till date; and

Whereas, as per the government order No. 846-JK (HME) of 2020 dated: 09-11-2020, village level committee comprising of Patwari, Village Level worker, store keeper FCS & CA, & ASHA have been constituted and Block Level Committee comprising of Tehsildar concerned (Chairman), Block Development Officer (Member), Block Medical Officer (Member Secretary) & Tehsil Supply officer (Member) have also been constituted for inclusion of the persons left out in the SECC Data- 2011; and

Whereas, it was ordered that Village Level Committee shall verify the on ground details of left out families and recommend registrations of the family to the Block Level Committee for its concurrence by the Chief Medical Officer who shall accord approval to the inclusion of the missing families; and

Whereas, the no. of registrations of such left out families has not been done as per the target which has necessitated holding of special camps; and

Whereas, in order to ensure coverage of all beneficiaries including left out persons in the SECC Data and addition of missing family members (Add on) special camps for one week shall be held at Girls Higher Secondary School, Reasi & Higher Secondary School, Katra from 1st December, 2021 (Wednesday) onwards from 10:30 AM to 04:30 PM.

In view of the above, following team of Officers / Officials is hereby deployed at the camp venues for complete coverage of beneficiaries under the Sehat scheme. The teams shall report on the established camps sites as per the scheduled date & time.

Block Medical Officer, Reasi & Katra under the overall supervision of Chief Medical Officer, Reasi shall ensure providing logistics support required for establishing camps viz. computer system, net connectivity, printer, scanner and banners etc to facilitate beneficiaries for smooth registrations on the portal. Block Medical Officers shall also provide sanitizers, masks and thermal scanners at the camps. Chief Medical Officer, Reasi shall deploy one ASHA worker at the camps.

Block Development Officer, Reasi & Katra shall ensure that the PRIs of the area are informed well in advance for the maximum mobilization of beneficiaries to the camps.

Similarly, CEO, Municipality, Katra and EO, Municipality, Reasi Shall ensure that the Councilors of the area are informed well in advance for mobilization of beneficiaries to the camps. They shall also depute one sanitary inspector/ Khilafwari inspector/ any official at the camps for the identification of beneficiaries.

Executive Engineer, PDD, Reasi shall ensure uninterrupted power supply at the venue during the camp schedule.

Medical Superintendent, District Hospital, Reasi and Block Medical Officer, Katra shall ensure that Aarogya Mitras report at the camps on the scheduled time along with their functional equipments.
