Subject:- Cancellation / De-registration of Societies registered under erstwhile J&K Societies Registration Act 1998 (Samvat)-1941 AD and who have not applied for Re-registration under Societies Registration Act 1860 with Registrar of Societies, Jammu.

Whereas, the J&K Societies Registration Act, 1998 (Samvat)-1941 AD stands repealed and the corresponding Central Societies Registration Act 1860 was made applicable, as per the Jammu & Kashmir Re-organization Act- 2019 (Notification No. 34 of 2019 Dated 9th August, 2019- issued by Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India).

Whereas, in reference to the Administrative Department's No. IND/DIC-169/2007 dated 19.04.2021, all the societies registered before 31.10.2019 under erstwhile J&K Societies Registration Act 1998 (Samvat)-1941 AD were required to get their societies re-registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 applicable as per Jammu & Kashmir Re-organization Act 2019. Accordingly, public notices were published from time to time in the leading Daily newspapers w.e.f. 20th April, 2021 to 07.12.2021 for submission of the requisite documents for Re-registration till the last date i.e. 18th December, 2021.

The candidates who participated in the said counselling and have been allotted seats as per their merit-rank preferences are hereby provisionally selected for admission to GNM Courses-2021 in various Colleges of Union Territory of J&K as per the Annexure "A" to this notification which is available on website of the Board www.jkbopee.org in only. The candidates are advised to report to their respective allotted Colleges/ Institutions w.e.f. **20-12-2021 to 27-12-2021 (03.00 PM)** along with following documents/ certificates:-

- Mark Cards of 12th class.
- Date of birth Certificate of 10th Class.
- Domicile Certificate
- Category Certificate, if any
- Medical fitness certificate.
- Any other certificates/ document as required by the College Authorities.

The candidates are advised to report to the allotted Colleges/Institutions up to 27th of December-2021 positively.

It shall be sole responsibility of the colleges/ Institutions concerned to ensure proper check and verification of documents/ eligibility as per Indian Nursing Council (INC) guidelines before the candidate is allowed for admission and in case of any discrepancy in the requisite documents is found the same shall be reported to the Board for further course of action under rules.

In order to complete admission process within the prescribed cut-off date (27-12-2021) the Colleges/ Institutions shall keep their admission counters open even on holidays/ off days and designate Nodal Officers to facilitate the candidates to complete their admission process well in time. However, the candidates should in their own interest avoid waiting for the last day to complete admission formalities since delay has the potential of causing hardships to the candidates only.

Further, due to non-availability of eligible reserved category candidates in the Govt. Institutions against below mentioned categories, the Board, as provided under Provision to Section 9(2) of J&K Reservation Act, 2004, converted 25 (twenty five) seats into Open Merit and filled up the same amongst the available eligible OM category candidates. The details of 25 category seats converted into OM are: - (SC-07 seats, OBC- 10 seats, SP-08 seats).
