CRIME REPORT

Drug peddler arrested

KULGAM: Police on Tuesday arrested a drug peddler and recovered contraband substances from his possession.

As per the details, on specific information, party of Police Station Kulgam established a checkpoint on Okay Road. During checking a suspicious person, who on noticing the police party tried to flee from the spot, was apprehended tactfully. He has been identified as Manzoor Ahmad Padder, son of Ab Majed Padder, resident of Okay Kulgam.

During search, officers were able to recover 75 grams of Charas, 400 grams of Cannabis Powder & 200 grams of dried Cannabis leaves from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR number 254/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at PS Kulgam and investigation has been initiated.

Rs 17,200 fine recovered from SoPs violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement Covid protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Tuesday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 17,200 Taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 73, 98, 300.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking Covid vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr. Suresh informed that as many as 1891 persons were administered second Covid vaccine doses across Ramban district today.

As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 2372 samples including 623 RT-PCR and 1749 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 1891 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

The team led by SHO Channi Himmat Inspr Deepak Katoch assisted by In-Charge Police Post Sainik Colony PSI Mohd Younis Khanday did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally rounded up a suspect namely Paras Dubey, son of Lt. Om Parkash, resident of Namain Katra Teh Katra Distt Reasi. During questioning, accused confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure stolen gold/silver ornaments and cash Rs 15000 was recovered from his possession.

It is pertinent to mention that the said accused person is a habitual thief and has previously been involved in FIR No. 21/2021 under section 457/380 IPC Police Station Channi Himmat Jammu, FIR No. 99/2021 under section 382/34 IPC Act Police Station Janipur. Further criminal history of the said accused person is being ascertained. The overall arrest and recoveries were made under the supervision of SP City South Deepak Digras.
