CRIME REPORT



Excise sleuths arrest 3 bootleggers; destroy 5 lts illicit liquor, 3 working stills, 250 Kg Lahan

JAMMU-RAJOURI: Sleuths of Excise Department destroyed 3 working stills, 5 lts of illicit liquor and 250 Kg of Lahan during different raids carried out to check the menace of illicit distillation and sale of illicit liquor in Excise Range Rajouri-Poonch. On directions of Excise Commissioner, Kishore Singh Chib and supervision of Deputy Excise Commissioner (Executive), Jammu Kusum Sharma, a team of Excise Eradication and enforcement wing led by Narinder Singh and Excise team Rajouri led by Mohammad Arif along with inspector Mohammad Farooq conducted raids in Devak Athal, Batal, Makool Nallah, Nether, Patal and Laam areas of Rajouri and recovered illicit liquor from the possession of three accused namely Jarnail Singh, Surinder Singh and Ranjot Singh, all residents of Devak Batal. The raiding team also recovered 3 working stills, 250 Kg Lahan raw material of illicit liquor, which is highly hazardous and injurious to health from state land and destroyed it on the spot.

27 bovines rescued, 3 smugglers arrested

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday foiled three bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 27 bovines in separate actions and arrested three smugglers.

As per details, a team headed by Incharge Police Post Chatyar Chingus, PSI Sahil Chowdhary under the supervision of DySP HQ Vinod Sharma during routine patrolling intercepted a Goods Carrier (JK11D 2731) which was coming from Lam area and was on its way to Surankote. During checking of vehicle, six bovines were found laden in it which were rescued and vehicle was seized. A case under relevant sections of law was also registered at Police Station Rajouri.

Meanwhile, Nagrota Police has rescued 8 bovines during Naka checking at Ban Toll Plaza Naka and seized a vehicle (JK02AD/1443). In this regard, FIR No. 466/2021 under sections 188, 34 of IPC and 11 of PCA was registered at Police Station Nagrota and two accused were arrested. The accused were identified as Bota Ram, son of Dewan Chand, resident of R S Pura, Jammu and Abdul Razak, son of Mohd Jamal, resident of Pulwama, Kashmir. The arrests and recoveries were made by SHO Nagrota Insp Vishav Pratap Singh under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Parupkar Singh.

In another incident, during Naka checking by a party from Police Station Majalta under control of Insp Virender Gupta SHO Majalta at Battal, police intercepted a truck (JK02 AH 5977) and found 13 bovines loaded in it, which were rescued. The bovine smuggler namely Balwinder Singh, son of Harpal Singh, resident of R S Pura Jammu was arrested and FIR No 115/2021 under sections 188/429 of IPC and 11 of PCA was registered against him at Police Station Majalta. The Naka was laid under supervision of SDPO Rammag DySP Bisham Dubey and overall supervision of SSP Vinod Kumar.

5 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Stations Nagrota, Channi Himmat, Gandhi Nagar and Police Post Pargwal acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 5 different vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a tractor-trolley without registration number seized by Nagrota police; 2 tipplers (JK02CN 1848 and JK02AD 0408) seized by Channi Himmat police; a tipper (JK02BX-1599) seized by Gandhi Nagar police and a tractor-trolley (JK02BJ 3066) seized by Pargwal police. The overall recoveries were made by SHO Nagrota Insp Vishav Pratap Singh, SHO Channi Himmat Insp Deepak Katoch, SHO Gandhi Nagar Insp Pankaj Sharma and Incharge Police Post Pargwal PSI Baljeet Singh Parihar in their respective jurisdictions. DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same.

Man held for illicit distillation; 20 lts illicit liquor, 100 lts Lahan destroyed

BISHNAH: Police on Wednesday arrested a man for illicit distillation and destroyed 20 lts of illicit liquor and 100 lts of Lahan.

As per details, in an act of alertness and prompt action, Police Station Bishnah acted swiftly on information received regarding sale of illicit liquor. On this, a party from Police Station Bishnah constituted by SDPO R S Pura Shabir Khan and led by SHO Bishnah Insp Joginder Singh raided a suspected location and rounded up a suspect namely Manohar Lal, son of Lal Chand, resident of Khairi, for selling illicit liquor in the area. During search, 20 lts illicit liquor and 100 lts Lahan were recovered from his possession which was destroyed on the spot. The accused was arrested and FIR No. 183/2021 under section 48(A) (E) (f) of Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Bishnah. The overall arrest and recoveries were made under supervision of SP HQs Rammish Gupta.
