



CRIME REPORT

Rs 25,400 fine recovered from SoPs violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Thursday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 25,400 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 74,41,800.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr. Suresh informed that as many as 1486 persons were administered second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district on Thursday.

As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 2,427 samples including 630 RT-PCR and 1,797 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 1,486 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

4 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams from Police Posts Bathindi, Sainik Colony, Beli Charana and Phallain Mandal acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 4 different vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles included a dumper (JK21F 8256) seized by Bathindi police; a tipper (JK21G 1072) seized by Sainik Colony police; a tractor-trolley (JK02AS 7412) seized by Beli Charana police and a tipper (JK02CU 8878) seized by Phallain Mandal police.

The overall recoveries were made by Incharge Police Post Bathindi PSI Mohd Ilyas, Incharge Police Post Sainik Colony PSI Mohd Younis Khanday, Incharge Police Post Beli Charana ASI Sanjeet Singh, Incharge Police Post Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal in their respective jurisdictions. DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same.

Woman among six narco smugglers arrested with heroin, Charas

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police achieved major success by recovering 250 gm Charas and 80 gm heroin from 5 narco smugglers during late night raids at suspected locations in R S Pura while another peddler was arrested in Kishtwar.

As per details, team of Police Station R S Pura constituted under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Shabir Khan led by SHO R S Pura Inspri Jai Pal Sharma raided at different locations during late night and rounded up five suspects namely Kuldeep Raj, son of Baldev Raj; Vijay Kumar, son of Nagar Mal; Narinder Kumar, son of Sat Paul, all residents of Ward No 7 R S Pura; Tara Devi, wife of Narinder Pal, resident of Puro Bhana and Janak Raj, son of Nand Lal, resident of Rangpur Sidher. On search, 250 gm Charas and 80 gm heroin was recovered from their possession.

All accused were arrested and FIR Nos. 235 & 236/21 under sections 8/20/21/22/29 of NDPS Act were registered against them at Police Station R S Pura. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SP Hqrs Rammish Gupta. Further investigation of the case is going on. Meanwhile, Kishtwar Police also arrested a drug peddler from Bus Stand area and recovered 70 gm Charas and intoxicating capsules from his possession.

It is pertinent to mention that Jaipreet Singh has been previously involved in number of FIRs for drug peddling and was continuing with illegal activities of drug peddling. Jammu Police is in the process of making more PIT NDPS doziers for some more peddlers involved in drug peddling. 
