

DC Rajouri reviews strategy to tackle imminent threat from Omicron

RAJOURI: In wake of the threat of new Covid-19 variant 'Omicron', the Deputy Commissioner Rajouri, Vikas Kundal on Thursday chaired a meeting to discuss the strategy for containment measures in the district.

'Tacking stock of the health infrastructure available with the health institutions to tackle the situation arising due to virus, the CMO

informed that there is no dearth of medical oxygen supply as well as all the requisite health infrastructure is available to meet any emergent situation.

Stressing upon the need to

take all possible measures to avert the imminent threat of omicron, the DC asked the Health Authorities to enhance the bed capacity besides he also directed the ACP to make sure that all the already set up five bedded panchayat level COVID care centers in 312 panchayats of the district are made functional within two days.

For the identification of the international travelers in the district, the DC asked the concerned officers from Police, Health and Revenue to constitute special teams for the purpose who shall con-

duct door to door visits to trace the international travelers in the district.

Emphasizing the need for aggressive testing, the DC said that testing is the only way to remain safe from the threat of omicron as it helps in the timely identification of the infected persons and reduces the chances of infection from them to others.

He also asked for strengthening of Nakas at entry points of the district and directed for aggressive testing of the persons entering the district to check the influx of virus in the district.
