## Man arrested for illicit distillation

RAJOURI: Police on Friday arrested a man along with a consignment of illicit liquor: Police said that a team headed by Incharge Police Post Chatyar Chingus, PSI Sahil Chowdhary under supervision of SHO Rajouri Fareed Ahmed intercepted a suspect in Dhanwan village of Rajouri, who was indulged in sale of illicit liquor among local population. Identified as Rakesh Kumar, son of Ram Lal, resident of Dhanwan, the accused was arrested on the spot and 20 lts of illicit liquor was seized from his possession. SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam said that action against unlawful activities including manufacturing and sale of illicit liquor would be checked properly. He also asked people to share information regarding all those indulged in the crime with local police stations and posts or with District Police Office so that necessary legal action can be initiated.

## Two theft cases solved; 5 arrested

RAMBAN/UDHAMPUR: Police on Friday solved two theft cases by arresting five thieves at Ramban and Udhampur.

As per details, on December 21, 2021, one Kripal Singh, son of Bahadur Singh, resident of Demote, District Ramban, lodged a written complaint at Police Station Ramban that during intervening night of December 20-21, 2021 that some unknown person/persons had stolen two tyres of his Sumo (JK141652), parked near



cafeteria morh, Ramban. On this, FIR no 219/2021, under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station Ramban. Acting swiftly under the guidance of SHO Ramban, Insp Sandeep Charak and DySP Hqrs Ramban, Pardeep Singh Sen under overall supervision of SSP Ramban, Mohita Sharma, two persons were arrested and during sustained questioning by PSI Meenakshi, both accused confessed their involvement in theft and further disclosed that they used vehicle (JK190737) in commission of crime. Both were arrested and on their disclosure, stolen tyres were also recovered. The accused were identified as Imtiaz Ahmed, son of Shamdin and Mohd Sadeeq, son of Noor Aliahim, both residents of Seri, Bhagana, Ramban.

Meanwhile, Udhampur Police also worked out a theft case and recovered stolen jewellery items. Based on complaint of one Vishal Abrol, son of Nanak Chand Abrol, resident of Shiv Nagar, Udhampur regarding theft of jewellery items from his shop, FIR No 482/21 under section 457/380 of IPC was registered and investigation was set into motion. During investigation a team led by Insp Chaman Gorka SHO Udhampur under the supervision of Anwaar U1 Haq Addl SP Udhampur and Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs. Udhampur conducted various raids at different suspected locations and some suspects were zeroed in.

During sustained questioning of suspects, two of them broke down and confessed the crime. On their disclosure stolen gold ornaments were also recovered. The accused were identified as Gallu Massi, son of Shafi Massi, resident of Shiv Nagar; Suresh Kumar, son of Jagdev Kumar, resident of Garhi and Rampal, son of Bansil Lal, resident of Roun Domail Udhampur (buyer of stolen property). Further investigation of the case is going on.

## Narco smuggler held with heroin

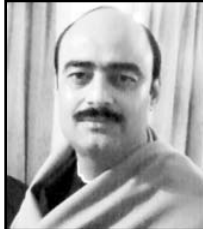

## Reasi Admn intensifies enforcement of notified rates of minor minerals; 4 loaded tippers, one excavator seized

REASI: To curb illegal mining and execute notified rates of minor minerals, district administration Reasi is conducting simultaneous inspections across the district.

Continuing the drive, Deputy Commissioner Reasi Charandeep Singh on Friday deputed teams of revenue officers, police and officials of the Mining department to launch a crackdown at different locations of the district including Chasana, Arnas, Kanjali, Salal and Pouni areas. The teams seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining and transportation of mining material in violation of mining rules. District Mineral Officer, Reasi (DMO) along with revenue officials visited Salal block No.27 from where a series of complaints against contractors were pouring in through local people and social media. An excavator machine used in illegal mining was seized on the spot. The teams also inspected minor mineral blocks to check display of notified rates, ensuring mining in demarcated area and within prescribed limits.

Further, local people and PRIs residing near mining blocks were requested to keep eye on mining activities and immediately report the matter regarding overcharging or illegal mining to the concerned Tehsildars or Control Room DC Office, Reasi.

## Grenade found in graveyard, defused

As per details, during earth filling at graveyard near Iqra Masjid Magarmal Bagh, locals found a grenade and informed police. Soon after getting information, a bomb disposal squad rushed to the spot and defused it safely.

## Policeman injured in road mishap succumbs

SRINAGAR: A policeman who had sustained critical injuries after being hit by a load carrier while performing his duty in Rainawari area of Srinagar succumbed to his injuries. As per details, on 13 December, a load-carrier (JK01C-3906) hit a police Head Constable Itikar Hussain (14/S) when he was performing his duty at Zaind Shah Masjid Chowk in Rainawari. The police constable was shifted to SKIMS, where he died after spending ten days in hospital. FIR No 69/2014 under relevant sections of law was registered and driver of vehicle was arrested, who was identified as Showkat Ismail Langoo, Hassanabad Rainawari.

Meanwhile, CCTV Footage of the incident has gone viral on social media where one can see a load-carrier knocking down a police officer while a woman had a miraculous escape.

## Theft at temple, cigarette store

JAMMU: In two separate incidents, thieves targeted a temple and a cigarette store in Jammu on Friday. As per details, Rajesh Kumar Raina, resident of Udheywala lodged a complaint with Bakshi Nagar Police that thieves targeted his cigarette store near Geeta Temple at Bakshi Nagar and decamped with cartons of cigarette worth Rs 4.5 lakh. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

Meanwhile, thieves also targeted Shiv Temple situated at B C Road, near Bus Stand and decamped with approximately Rs 3,000 from donation box. Temple management member Satvir Kumar has lodged a complaint with police in this regard.

## Notorious drug peddler arrested

HANDWARA: Police on Friday arrested a notorious drug peddler and recovered contraband substances from his possession.

As per details, a team from Police Station Handwara at a checkpoint established at Chotipora intercepted a Swift car (JK01S 7022) driven by one Tanveer Ahmad Wani, son of Mohd Ishaq, resident of Kulgam, Kupwara. During checking, officers recovered 50 gm heroin from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime has also been seized. Accordingly, FIR number 363/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Handwara and investigation started.

## Con-men father-son arrested from Punjab

REASI: Police on Friday nabbed con-men father & son in Reasi.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Reasi by one Ghulam Rasool, resident of Ward No. 7 Reasi that one Mohd Sharif, son of Roshan Din along with his son Mohd Tariq has duped and took huge amount from him on pretext of construction of residential house. The accused was working as contractor in Reasi area and after taking advance money of Rs 12 lakh from applicant, he along with his family went underground.

After preliminary enquiry it came to light that accused has also purchased building material from some shopkeepers in Reasi and cheated them by selling it elsewhere. He used to operate in similar manner and loot money from general public of Reasi. FIR no. 240/2021 under section 420 of IPC was registered at Police Station Reasi and
