Ahmed, son of Gulam Ali, resident of Lower Ragoora, Tehsil and District Jammu. The accused was arrested and a case under relevant sections was registered against him at Police Station Channi Himmat. The overall arrest and recovery was made under supervision of SDPO City East Sajjad Sarwar.

Meanwhile, a party from Police Station Rammagar led by Insp Pushpinder Singh SHO Rammagar under supervision of Anwar-ul-Haq Addl SP Udhampur, Dr Bhisham Dubey SDPO Rammagar laid a Naka at Kauga Naka point and stopped a vehicle (JK14F-3898) coming from Udhampur towards Rammagar for checking. During checking of vehicle, 6 gm Heroin (Chitta) was recovered from possession of two accused, identified as Akash Kharkha, son of Yash Pal, resident of W.No. 6, Rammagar and Rakesh Singh, son of Yash Pal, resident of W.No. 11, Ramanagar, who were arrested on the spot. FIR No. 201/2021 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Rammagar.

As per details, a party of Police Station Udhampur led by Insp Chaman Gorka SHO Udhampur under supervision of Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs. Udhampur during routine patrolling near Bus Stand area caught a suspect who was trying to hide himself from police. During search of suspect, 33 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered. The accused, identified as Mohd Wasim, son of Mohd Mushtaq, resident of Bali, Udhampur was arrested and FIR under relevant sections of law was registered against him at Police Station Udhampur.

During the course of investigation, with the help of CCTV footages and other technical tools, it came to surface that accused has fled away from District Ganderbal to Handwara. Accordingly, a special team was dispatched to Handwara to nab him. A tip off was received that accused was moving towards Jammu to evade his arrest, after which he was intercepted at Sangam with help of Anantnag Police. GANDERBAL: Police on Thursday solved a burglary case by arresting an accused involved in commission of crime and recovered stolen property worth lakhs from his possession.

As per details, on November 29, 2021, Police Station Kangan received a complaint from a shopkeeper namely Mohd Saif Khan, son of Irfan Ahmad Khan, resident of Tawheedpora Kangan regarding burglary in his jewellery shop during intervening night of November 28-29, at Tawheedpora, Kangan. Accordingly, FIR No.140/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Kangan and investigation started. On receipt of this information, a special Police team headed by SHO Police Station Kangan on directions of SSP Ganderbal Nikhil Borkar under the supervision of SDPO Kangan was constituted.

During the course of investigation, with the help of CCTV footages and other technical tools, it came to surface that accused has fled away from District Ganderbal to Handwara. Accordingly, a special team was dispatched to Handwara to nab him. A tip off was received that accused was moving towards Jammu to evade his arrest, after which he was intercepted at Sangam with help of Anantnag Police. He was identified as Bilal Ahmad Lone, son of Mohd Akbar Lone, resident of Marigam Handwara. On his disclosure stolen property worth lakhs were recovered by Police. Further investigation is in progress and more recoveries are expected.

Burglary case solved; accused arrested, stolen property worth lakhs recovered

Theft case worked out; accused arrested, stolen batteries recovered

UDHAMPUR: Police on Thursday worked out a theft case with arrest of an accused.

As per details, based on a complaint of theft/burglary by Suresh Gupta, resident of Housing Colony, a team of Police Station Udhampur, led by Insp Chaman Gorka SHO Udhampur under the supervision of Anwar ul Haq Addl SP Udhampur and Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs Udhampur conducted raids at different locations. The police team, after collaborating technical and human intelligence, arrested accused who was identified as Kartar Singh, son of Chain Singh, resident of Domail, Udhampur from near Jakhani Naka on National Highway. During sustained questioning, he confessed that he had stolen three batteries and some clothes from vehicles parked at Housing Colony, Udhampur. With the arrest of thief, police succeeded in solving a theft case. Police is also working on involvement of some more accused in the crime.

10 bovines rescued, vehicle seized**STATE TIMES NEWS**

KATHUA: In an endeavour to contain activities of Bovine smuggling in the district and under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal, a team of Police Station Rajbagh foiled bovine smuggling attempt by rescuing 10 bovines and seized a vehicle.

As per details, a police team led by Insp Amit Sangra SHO Rajbagh under supervision of SDPO Border Sachit Mahajan while performing special Naka checking duty on NH Rajbagh noticed a suspicious Truck (JK02AE-1686) which was signaled to stop for checking. Sensing danger, driver of vehicle managed to flee from the spot leaving behind the vehicle. During checking, 10 bovines were found laden in vehicle which were rescued and vehicle was seized. FIR No. 248/2021 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered at Rajbagh Police Station and further investigation started.
