Ahmed, son of Gulam Ali, resident of Lower Ragoora, Tehsil and District Jammu. The accused was arrested and a case under relevant sections was registered against him at Police Station Channi Himmat. The overall arrest and recovery was made under supervision of SDPO City East Sajjad Sarwar.

Meanwhile, a party from Police Station Ramnagar led by Insp Pushpinder Singh SHO Ramnagar under supervision of Anwar-ul-Haq Addl SP Udhampur; Dr Bhishm Dubey SDPO Ramnagar laid a Naka at Kaugha Naka point and stopped a vehicle (JK14F3898) coming from Udhampur towards Ramnagar for checking. During checking of vehicle, 6 gm Heroin (Chitta) was recovered from possession of two accused, identified as Akash Kharkha, son of Yash Pal, resident of W.No. 6, Ramnagar and Rakesh Singh, son of Yash Pal, resident of W.No. 11, Ramanagar; who were arrested on the spot. FIR No. 201/2021 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Ramnagar.

Bootlegger nabbed with 33 bottles of illicit liquor

UDHAMPUR: Police on Thursday nabbed a bootlegger and recovered 33 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Udhampur led by Insp Chaman Gorka SHO Udhampur under supervision of Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs. Udhampur during routine patrolling near Bus Stand area caught a suspect who was trying to hide himself from police. During search of suspect, 33 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered. The accused, identified as Mohd Wasim, son of Mohd Mushtaq, resident of Bali, Udhampur was arrested and FIR under relevant sections of law was registered against him at Police Station Udhampur.

Theft case worked out; accused arrested, stolen batteries recovered

UDHAMPUR: Police on Thursday worked out a theft case with arrest of an accused.

As per details, based on a complaint of theft/burglary by Suresh Gupta, resident of Housing Colony, a team of Police Station Udhampur, led by Insp Chaman Gorka SHO Udhampur under the supervision of Anwar ul Haq Addl. SP Udhampur and Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs Udhampur conducted raids at different locations. The police team, after collaborating technical and human intelligence, arrested accused who was identified as Kartar Singh, son of Chain Singh, resident of Domail, Udhampur from near Jakhani Naka on National Highway. During sustained questioning, he confessed that he had stolen three batteries and some clothes from vehicles parked at Housing Colony, Udhampur. With the arrest of thief, police succeeded in solving a theft case. Police is also working on involvement of some more accused in the crime.

10 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

KATHUA: In an endeavour to contain activities of Bovine smuggling in the district and under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal, a team of Police Station Rajbagh foiled bovine smuggling attempt by rescuing 10 bovines and seized a vehicle.

As per details, a police team led by Insp Amit Sangra SHO Rajbagh under supervision of SDPO Border Sachit Mahajan while performing special Naka checking duty on NH Rajbagh noticed a suspicious Truck (JK02AE-1686) which was signaled to stop for checking. Sensing danger, driver of vehicle managed to flee from the spot leaving behind the vehicle. During checking, 10 bovines were found laden in vehicle which were rescued and vehicle was seized. FIR No. 248/2021 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered at Rajbagh Police Station and further investigation started.

Man arrested for kidnapping, raping minor girl

UDHAMPUR: Police on Thursday nabbed a man for kidnapping and raping a minor girl.

As per details, based on a complaint by a resident of Basantgarh at Police Station Basantgarh that his minor girl went missing, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Basantgarh and investigation started.

On this, a team of Police Station Basantgarh led by Insp Sohan Singh SHO Basantgarh under the supervision of Anwar ul Haq Addl. SP Udhampur and Dr.

Bhishm Dubey SDPO Ramnagar was constituted and raids were conducted in order to recover the missing girl besides arresting the accused.

Based on reliable input, the minor kidnapped girl was recovered by a police team from Gandhtop area within 24 hours of registration of case and was safely brought back to Police Station Basantgarh, where in her statement, she stated that accused had raped her and fled from the spot.

Subsequently, police team also succeeded in arresting accused person namely Liaquat Ali, son of Hameed under sections 363/376 and 4 of POCSO Act from the area under jurisdiction of Police Station Basantgarh. The identification of the arrested accused was conducted in which victim identified him. Further investigation of the case is underway.

Man crushed under train
