CISF restores bag containing Rs 2.53 lakh lost at R K Ashram Metro Station to owner

NEW DELHI: Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) on Thursday restored a bag containing cash amount of Rs 2,53,545 lost at R K Ashram Metro Station to the rightful owner. On December 1 at about 1640 hrs, the CISF personnel deployed at Karol Bagh Metro Station, noticed an unclaimed bag lying on the output roller of X-BIS machine.

"The CISF enquired from the nearby passengers, but no one came forward to claim the bag. Immediately, he informed his senior and Station Controller, who in turn rushed to the spot and the bag was checked from the security point of view," said an official statement by CISF.

"After ascertaining that there was no dangerous/hazardous item inside the bag, it was opened. On opening the bag, cash amounting to Rs 2,53,545 was found inside the bag. Thereafter, the bag con-

taining cash was deposited with the Station Controller and an announcement were made at the station/nearby stations in this regard. After sometime, a female passenger namely Janmuni Das, 29, resident of Bishnupur Road, Guwahati, Assam, came at security point and claimed the bag," the statement further said.

"She said that she was in hurry and forgot to collect her bag after putting the same for x-ray screening. She also informed that she came to Delhi with her husband for relative's wedding shopping. Thereafter, she was brought to Station Controller Room. After proper verification the bag containing cash was handed over to her. On getting her bag along with cash Rs 2,53,545 and all the items intact, she thanked CISF and appreciated the alertness and honesty displayed by CISF personnel," it added.

Demanding a detailed enquiry in the matter, Gupta said that all such erring officers should be transferred from Jammu so that peace can be restored among shopkeepers.
