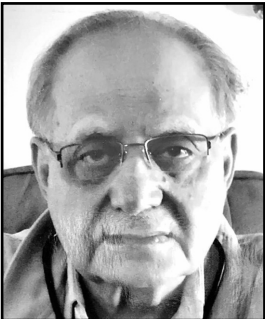

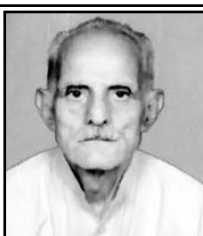

CRIME REPORT

4 drug peddlers arrested; psychotropic substance recovered

SOPORE: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs from the society, Police on Thursday arrested four drug peddlers in Sopore and recovered psychotropic substances from their possession.

As per details, a party of Police Post Bus-stand arrested four drug peddlers during checking and recovered 768 capsules of Spasmoproxyvon from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No 303/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Sopore and investigation started.

Rs 49,800 fine recovered from SoPs violators in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Thursday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs. 49,800 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 77,50,500.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 1,055 persons were administered second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district on Thursday. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 2,748 samples including 609 RT-PCR and 2,139 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 1,055 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

Stolen bike recovered; notorious lifter arrested, juvenile booked

UDHAMPUR: Police on Thursday arrested a bike-lifter and booked a juvenile after recovering stolen bike from their possession.

As per details, acting on a written complaint of one Rajesh Singh, son of Nanak Singh, resident of Sangoor, Udhampur stating that some unknown thief/thieves have stolen his bike (JK14A-4952) from outside his house, FIR No. 487/2021 was registered at Police Station Udhampur and investigation started.

During course of investigation, a team of Police Station Udhampur led by Insp. Chaman Gorkha SHO Udhampur under the supervision of Addl SP Udhampur Anwaar Ul Haq and DySP Hqrs Udhampur Sahil Mahajan raided at different places for search of accused as well as stolen vehicle. On further investigation, Udhampur Police zeroed on one suspect namely Abhishek Dogra, son of Purshtam Kumar, resident of Lambi Gali, Udhampur who was subjected to thorough questioning wherein he broke down and confessed crime. He also disclosed involvement of a juvenile also. On the disclosure of accused person, police has recovered the stolen bike from Cooperative office Udhampur.

42 bovines rescued; 8 smugglers arrested

RAMBAN/JHAJJAR KOTLI: Police on Thursday foiled two bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 42 bovines and arrested eight smugglers.

As per details, during the intervening night of December 29-30, acting on the specific inputs of transportation of bovines, different police parties of Police Stations Batote and Chanderkote intercepted 6 vehicles at Nashri & Chanderkote, which were carrying bovine animals in contravention of permission of competent authority. Overall 32 bovines were rescued. FIR Nos 131, 132, 133 & 134/2021 in Police Station Batote and FIR Nos 158 & 159/2021 in Police Station Chanderkote under section 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered while six persons were arrested, who were identified as Latief Ahmad, son of Bashir Ahmad, resident of Beli Charana, Jammu; Mohd Ziarat, son of Mohd Akram, resident of Chanderkote; Mohd Farooq, son of Shah Mohd, resident of Bajalta, Jammu; Mohd Iqbal, son of Gulab Din, resident of Gujjar Colony, Jammu; Latief, son of Jamal Din, resident of Rascian, Tehsil & District Udhampur and Arshad Ahmad, son of Layakat Ali, resident of Saranpur, UP. The overall rescue operation and arrests were made by police parties under supervision of Insp Ajeet Singh SHO Batote, Insp Afzal Wani SHO Chanderkote and Pardeep Singh Sen DySP Hqrs Ramban under overall supervision of SSP Ramban, Mohita Sharma.

Meanwhile, specific information received through reliable source regarding bovine smuggling, a team of Police Station Jhajjar Kotli headed by Insp Devinder Singh laid a special Naka at Suketar, Jhajjar Kotli for checking of vehicles. During checking, a Truck (JK03K/3449) stopped and on through checking, it was found laden with 10 bovines which were rescued. Truck driver namely Parvez Ahmed, son of Adrish Ahmed, resident of Surinsar along with associate namely Medhu Mohd, son of Abdul Rashid, resident of Marh were arrested on spot and FIR No.199/2021 under section 188 of IPC and 11 of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Jhajjarkotli. The recovery and arrests were made under supervision of SDPO Nagrota Parupkar Singh and SP Rural Jammu Sanjay Sharma.

Sarpanch among three booked under PSA for narcotics peddling

SRINAGAR: Kupwara Police on Thursday detained three persons including a Sarpanch under Public Safety Act (PSA) for their involvement in narcotics peddling in the area. A warrant under PSA against trio was issued by the Divisional Commissioner Kashmir after dossiers were submitted by J&K Police, of Kupwara district. Trio was involved in narcotics peddling in rampant ways and were continuously indulged in the crime besides luring local youth towards the menace. Police said that trio have been detained and lodged in jail after PSA detention orders were issued by Divisional Commissioner Kashmir.

They were identified as Sarpanch Darpora Lolab, Manzoor Ahmad Lone (42) son of Abdul Jabbar Lone, resident of Darpora Lolab who was booked in three cases earlier including FIR 49/2012 under sections 8/20 of NDPS Act at Police Station Lalpora, FIR 56/2017 under section 8/20 of NDPS Act at Police Station Lalpora and FIR 56/2019 under section 8/20 of NDPS Act at Police Station Lalpora.

Another peddler was identified as Bilal Ahmad Ganie son of Sonaulah Ganie resident of Batpora Hayhama Kupwara and was booked in FIR 130/2016 under section 8/20 of NDPS Act at Police Station Kupwara while third peddler Tariq Ahmad Bhat, son of Ghulam Nabi Bhat, resident of Lalpora Kolav Kupwara was earlier booked in FIR 24/2020 under section 8/20 of NDPS Act at Police Station Lalpora. Senior Superintendent of Police Kupwara, Youghal Manhas said that action over nar-

cotics peddling is one of top priority of Jammu and Kashmir police for which necessary actions as well as preventive measures are being taken and action against these three persons and their detention under PSA is a step forward to tighten noose over narcotic peddlers.

33-year-old driver found dead in suspicious conditions

ANANTNAG: Body of a 33-year-old driver was found under suspicious circumstances in village Nowgam in Dooru in Anantnag district on Thursday.

As per details, body of Aijaz Ahmed Wagay, son of Ghulam Hassan Wagay, resident of Nowgam, was found in his native village and later on brought to the hospital by his relatives. On preliminary examination by doctors, no external bodily injury was found. An enquiry under section 174 CrPC has been initiated to ascertain the cause of death.

Ex-Sarpanch killed in mishap

RAJOURI: An ex-Sarpanch got killed in a road mishap at Chingus on Thursday. As per details, Mohd Azam, son of Deen Mohd, resident of Dhanwakote, Sector Chingus met with an accident while driving a motorcycle due to which he got injured. He was shifted to District Hospital Rajouri where doctors declared him as brought dead. The body is presently lying at District Hospital Rajouri and Police is investigating the matter.

Labourer receives burn injuries while repairing HT line

Fraudster nabbed for duping people over PMAY
