

Procurement of paddy by FCI extended till Dec 31

JAMMU: Managing Director; Indian Farmers Fertilizer Cooperative Limited (IFFCO) Kisan, Sandeep Malhotra, on Tuesday called on Principal Secretary, Agriculture Production and Farmers Welfare, Navin K Choudhary.

The team from IFFCO Kisan gave a detailed presentation to the Principal Secretary explaining various technological interventions in their expertise. The team explained how technological methods, or 'agritech', like remote sensing, hyperspectral imagery, digital profiling, portable soil testing facilities could help give hyperlocal solutions most suited to a particular farmland and its respective crop. The IFFCO Kisan would also work in partnership with NABARD to give a fillip to agriculture and allied sectors in J&K, the team further informed.

Principal Secretary asked the IFFCO Kisan representatives to submit a detailed proposal and subsequently start implementing their technologies in specified spots on pilot basis.

It was informed that crops like almonds, walnuts, olives, turmeric and few others among medicinal plants would be tested initially.

Sharing his aim of boosting horticulture in previously untapped regions of the UT, Principal Secretary informed that the Horticulture department has planted 10 lakh plants in the last year and thrice the number is expected to be planted this year. The department aims to promote cultivation of Aloe vera and lemongrass in water deficient areas of the UT, he added. He said we are trying to give end-to-end solutions to the local

farmers, so as to ensure that they are assisted from planting to marketing. Elucidating various handholding schemes for farmers' welfare being run by the government, Principal Secretary informed that under the Integrated Dairy Development Scheme, the UT is going to become 30 percent surplus in milk production. Similarly, under Parvaz, farmers are being given 50 percent subsidy on air cargo. It was revealed that the department


is going to push towards making the UT self sufficient in cattle feed requirement as well.

Those present in the meeting included Director General Horticulture Kashmir; Ajaz Ahmad Bhat; MD J&K Agro Industries Development Corporation, Dr Arun Kumar Manhas; Director Horticulture Jammu, Ram Sevak; Director Horticulture, P&M J&K, Vishesh Paul Mahajan; Director

Agriculture Jammu, KK Sharma; Director Agriculture Kashmir; Mohammad Iqbal Chowdhary and General Manager, NABARD Jammu. Meanwhile, in another meeting between officers from FCI and the Principal Secretary, it was decided that procurement of paddy, at MSP, in Mandis would be extended till December 31, this year.

The concerned officers were directed to resolve payment issues within a week's time.

- The concerned institution/s shall visit the JKBOSE website www.Jkbose.nic.in to log into their respective Account. To submit the Permission-cum-Admission forms of their students, the School shall able to fill the examination form by entering the Registration No. of the candidate which is available in the respective school account.
- In case the R.R No./R.R record of any student who is registered by the school is not available in the school account, the concerned institution may contact the JKBOSE in this regard on the mail ID computercellitss@gmail.com .
- After entering the R.R No. of the candidate shall be displayed. The school has to only upload the signatures of the candidate and submit the form after checking/verifying particulars, subjects and other details.
- Fee can be paid through online mode only.
- Schools shall not charge any additional amount from the students (apart from the prescribed fee) for submission of their forms.
- The concerned Head of the institutions shall ensure that the verified Application forms are forwarded to the JKBOSE from the Principal Account by clicking on the "Push data to BOSE" option available in the Principal's account.
- The Specially abled candidates with a disability of Fifty percent (50%) or more are exempted from paying Examination Fee. However, they shall take a printout of the Examination Form submitted online and get it attested by the Head of the concerned Academic institution and submit the same In the concerned District/Tehsil Office/s of the JKBOSE, along with the Disability Certificate issued by the concerned Medical Board of Doctors.
- Only those Academic Institutions who are affiliated with JKBOSE for this Academic Session are eligible to fill the examination froms.
- in case of any correction except for already registered particulars, the same my be reported to the concerned Sub/Branch office along with relevant documents within one week of termination of service falling which suitable penalty shall be imposed and the responsibility lies with the concerned institution.
- After completion of online service, all the institutions shall generate the checklist from their respective school accounts and submit the same to the concerned Sub/branch office duly signed and stamped by the head of the Institution, within ten days positively.
- For any query, the Heads of the Affiliated Academic Institutions are Informed to approach the concerned Oistrict/Tehsil offices of the JKBOSE. They can also mail their queries at computercellitss@gmail.com or is examination jd@jkbose.co.in.
