Shri Shamsher Singh, son of the soil a brave & fearless Dy. Commandant, of BSF Attained Martyrdom on 10/12/2001, while fighting with Militants in Kulgam-Srinagar at Mid - Night.

Born on 22nd Oct. 1947 in Village Manchak, Jourian he Joined BSF on 21st May 1966. He served in different states of India, **when Militancy was at Peak/Prone in Punjab he served from 1980 to 1988**, in Fasalga, Amritsar, Faridkot, and Gurdaspur.

After Punjab he served in Militancy affected Kashmir Valley from 1989 to 2001 till his Death in **Kulgam**. The other Areas where he served were- Bandipura, Tral, Srinagar City, Noorabad, Rawalpura, Nelu, Shopian & Kupwara.

In 1990, he was saved the life of two Ladies who were buried under the Debris in a Land Slide. For this, J&K Govt, recommended his name for Life Saving Medal.

CRIME REPORT

8 arrested for damaging Jammu’s Selfie Point

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday arrested eight miscreants for damaging Jammu's selfie point at BC Road a couple of days ago.

As per details, on December 6, 2021, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Bus Stand that Selfie Point established at BC Road, Jammu opposite Lords Inn Hotel has been damaged by some unidentified miscreants.

On this case FIR No 77/2021 under sections 434/427 of IPC, section 3 of prevention of damage public property Act and investigation started. After this, special police team of Police Station Bus stand was constituted under the supervision of SDPO City North Sharad Kalu. The team, led by SHO Bus stand Inspr Deepankar Singh did strenuous efforts and with help of CCTV footages of the area finally rounded up a suspect namely Abhishek Gill, son of Muntazir Gill, resident of Shahidi Chowk Jammu. During intensive questioning, he disclosed name of Nikhil Gill, son of Manga Gill, resident of Bakshi Nagar Jammu who was also involved in the case and was arrested from his residence at Bakshi Nagar.

Taking the lead forward, all other accused who were involved in this case were identified and arrested by police, who were identified as Goldy, working at Roop Nagar; Christopher, son of Lazer Gill, resident of Bakshi Nagar; Heaven, son of Naresh, resident of Bakshi Nagar; Vinay, resident of Bakshi Nagar Jammu; Gabriel, resident of Bakshi Nagar and Shubam, resident of Bakshi Nagar. The overall arrests were made under the supervision of SP City North Mohita Sharma. Further investigation of the case is going on.

Missing Akhnoor woman, minor daughter recovered from Maharashtra

AKHNOOR: Police on Wednesday traced a missing woman and her minor daughter from Maharashtra.

As per details, on June 27, 2021, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Akhnoor by father of a kidnapped minor girl that his daughter and wife went missing since June 19, 2021. On this, FIR no. 167/2021 under sections 363/366 of IPC was registered at Police Station Akhnoor and investigation started. After this, special teams of Police Station Akhnoor under supervision of SDPO Akhnoor were constituted. A team led by SHO Akhnoor Insp Hilal Mohd Azhar and PSI Karnail Singh Parihar connected various leads and after hectic efforts and with the support of technical assistance, finally recovered the kidnapped minor girl and her mother from Maharashtra along with accused namely Mankirpal Singh, son of Gurdial Singh, resident of Begeawal, Amritsar.

Shop burglary case solved, accused arrested

AKHNOOR: Police on Wednesday solved a shop burglary case by arresting accused at Akhnoor.

As per details, Police Station Akhnoor received a complaint from a shopkeeper namely Kewal Krishan, son of Babu Ram, resident of village Guda Jagir Tehsil Akhnoor regarding burglary in shop during intervening night of November 13-14 at Kalewali Kaleeth, Akhnoor. Accordingly, FIR No.291/2021 under sections 457/380/427 of IPC was registered and investigation started. In this regard, under supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Varun Jandial, special Police team headed by SHO



Police Station Akhnoor Insp Hilal Mohd Azhar and PSI Karnail Singh Parihar was constituted. During the course of investigation, with help of CCTV footage and other technical tools, the burglar was identified as Mukhtyar Ahmed, son of Nazir Ahmed, resident of Village Chassana, Tehsil Chassana District Reasi. In this connection, a special team was dispatched to Reasi and other areas to nab the accused, who was finally arrested and taken into custody. During the course of investigation, the accused confessed his crime and on his disclosure, stolen cash was also recovered. Further investigation is under progress and more recoveries are expected. The hunt to nab other associates is also on. The overall operation was conducted under guidance of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma. SDPO Akhnoor appealed to shopkeepers for installing CCTVs at their business premises besides sharing information with Police if any suspicious person is found roaming in the area.

Chain snatcher arrested

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday arrested a notorious snatcher and recovered one gold chain, gold locket and a pair of gold ear-ring.

As per details, on December 4, 2021 a complaint was lodged at Police Station Janipur by Veena Devi, wife of Vijay Kumar, resident of 280-A, Krishna Vihar Janipur that some unknown bike-borne snatcher restrained her way and snatched her ear-ring. On this, FIR No. 125/2021 under sections 341/382 of IPC got registered and investigation was entrusted to ASI Mohi Din. After hectic efforts and analysis of CCTV footages and analysis of CDR /tower location, a suspect namely Jatinder Verma, son of Suresh Verma, resident of 176-Extn, Janipur Colony, Near Ram Sharan Ashram, Janipur was arrested. During sustained questioning, he confessed his involvement in crime and snatched gold jewellery was also recovered on his disclosure. The motorcycle (Jk02BN-1395) used for commissioning crime was also seized. During further investigation, FIR No. 97/2021 under section 382 of IPC Police Station Janipur was also worked out and on disclosure of accused, a snatched gold chain and locket were also recovered. Further investigation is going on and more recovery is expected in coming days.

Two narco smugglers arrested, heroin & Ganja recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Wednesday arrested two narco-smugglers with heroin and Ganja.

As per details, a team of Police Post Bathindi led by Incharge Police Post Bathindi PSI Mohd Ilyas, during Naka checking, rounded up a suspect who turned suspicious on seeing police. On search, 10 gm heroin was recovered from possession of suspect later identified as Javed Ahmed, son of Shar Ali Chowdhury, resident of Sunjwan. Similarly, at another Naka laid by team of Police Post Narwal led by Incharge Police Post Narwal SI Achal Rana, police rounded up a suspect namely Mohd Zaffar Alam, son of Late Nabi Jaan, resident of Rajeev Nagar, Narwal. During search, 1 Kg 450 gm Ganja was recovered from his possession.

Police has taken cognizance of both cases and arrested accused. The overall arrests and recoveries in both the cases were made under the supervision of SDPO City East Sajjad Sarwar.

Scooter-rider nabbed with 2.3 Kg poppy straw

As per details, a Naka party headed by ASI Sham Lal established a Naka at Rajpura and stopped a Vespa scooter (JK02AM/9386) for checking driven by one Sohan Lal, resident of Anant Ram, resident of Gurha, Keran, Bantalab, Tehsil Bhalwal. During checking of scooter, about 2 Kg 300 gm Poppy straw (Bhukki) like narcotic substance was recovered from the rider. He was arrested and FIR No 172/2021 under section 8/15 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Kanachak.
