HC upholds PSA of notorious criminal

JAMMU: Justice Tashi Rabstan of Jammu & Kashmir High Court upheld PSA of Yudhvir Singh, a notorious criminal, who was also involved in firing over Choudhary Nagar Singh's house.

While dismissing plea, Justice Tashi Rabstan after hearing Advocate Jagpaul Singh for detainee whereas AAG Asen Sawhney for UT observed that if one looks at the acts, J&K Public Safety Act 1978 is designed for, is to prevent. The acts those are prejudicial to security of State or maintenance of public order. The acts, indulged in by persons, who act in concert with other persons and quite often such activity has national level ramifications. These acts are preceded by a good amount of planning and organisation by set of people fascinated in tumultuousness. They are not like ordinary law and order crimes.

Justice Tashi Rabstan further observed that in present case, petitioner has been involved in many criminal activities and against him sixteen FIRs have been lodged under various sections of IPC at different Police Stations, including FIR No.10/2005 under

Section 382 RPC registered at Police Station Gangyal regarding snatching of motor cycle; FIR No.47/2005 under Sections 379/109 RPC registered at Police Station Gangyal regarding stealing of motor cycle; FIR No.67/2005 under Section 307/34 RPC and 3/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Nowabad regarding making fire on complainant therein; FIR No.93/2006 under Section 4/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station R S Pura regarding recovering one Toka; FIR No.101/2007 under Sections 307/147/148/341 RPC, 4/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station R.S.Pura regarding attacking the complainant therein with a sharp edged weapon; FIR No.57/2009 under Section 4/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Bari Brahma; FIR No.152/2009 under Sections 307/341/34 RPC registered at Police Station Gangyal regarding attacking upon the complainant with a sharp edged weapon; FIR No.161/2010 under Sections 307/452/147 RPC, 3/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Bari Brahma regarding firing upon the complainant therein with a pistol;

FIR No.164/2010 under Sections 307/34 RPC, 3/25, 7/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Channi Himmat regarding recovering of one pistol, 04 live rounds, one katta; FIR No.73/2013 under Section 4/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station R.S. Pura; FIR No.160/2016 under Section 3/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station R.S. Pura; FIR No.192/2016 under Sections 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act registered at Police Station R.S. Pura regarding recovery of heroine like substance; FIR No.240/2017 under Sections 307/109 RPC, 3/25, 4/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station R.S. Pura regarding firing upon the complainant therein; FIR No.254/2017 under Section 3/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Bahu Fort; FIR No.102/2020 under Section 3/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station R.S. Pura and FIR No.91/2021 under Sections 307/120-B IPC, 3/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar, Jammu. "It seems the petitioner is a hardcore criminal, has become a terror figure among the people of the area and the actions taken against him under

the ordinary law from time to time have not been proved to be deterrent. As per objections, earlier also in the year 2017 the petitioner-detenu was booked under the Public Safety Act. It seems the petitioner-detenu instead of mending his ways has continuously been indulging in criminal activities and has not shown any respect for the law of the land, as such the petitioner-detenu has created a sense of alarm, scare and a feeling of insecurity in the minds of the public of the area, has become a chronic fear amongst the people of the area.

Activities of the petitioner are of hardcore criminal and habitual of indulging in acts of violence, such as murder, attempt to murder, assault, land grabbing etc. The record so produced reveals that the petitioner-detenu has been indulging in illegal trade in an organized manner, which is a great threat for sustaining conservation values of society and that drug trafficking also possess great threat to the society for the reason that the proceeds of the drug sale can be utilized for financing of other criminal activities," the Court observed and upheld PSA of accused.

EJAC demands regularisation of adhoc, DRWs; holds protest

SRINAGAR: JK Employees Joint Action Committee (EJAC) held a protest demonstration at Press Enclave Srinagar in support of their demands and urged the Government to fulfill all pending demands at the earliest. Led by President EJAC, Mohd Rafique Rather, a number of employee leaders along

scores of employees holding placards in their hands raised slogans in support of their demands.

Speaking on the occasion, Rather said that regularisation of adhoc, temporary and daily wagers is an issue which should be addressed on priority. He said that regularisation of big chunk of such employees is the most genuine and legitimate demand which has been agreed and accepted by respective Governments but it is really strange that nothing

has happened on the ground level in this regard. "Employees are performing their duties in extremely tough conditions and have always been standing shoulder to shoulder with other regularised employees but still they are paid a meager pay that too after even months, which is a human right violation," he added, stressing upon the Government to implement minimum wages act as per Supreme court ruling till a regularization policy for welfare of suffering workers.

Govt to make Online Grievance Redressal accessible to all: Dr Jitendra

NEW DELHI: Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh informed the Lok Sabha on Wednesday that the government has initiated the process to make Online Grievance Redressal accessible to all and for this purpose, Common Service Center (CSC) has been engaged to make CPGRAMS more inclusive and accessible to all including the differently-abled citizens.

Pertinent to mention that CPGRAMS (Centralised Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System) is an online platform available to the citizens 24x7 to lodge their grievances to the public authorities on any subject related to Department of Pension and Pensions Welfare, Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) in January 2021.

The Minister informed that CPGRAMS has been integrated with several other Grievance portals. PMO PG portal, President Secretariat PG portal, Cabinet Secretariat PG portal and Grievance portals of Department of Pension and Pensions Welfare, Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) in January 2021.

Micro Small and Medium Enterprises and Securities and Exchange Board of India are integrated with CPGRAMS at the backend. CPGRAMS has also linked through the web API with Grievance Portals of the UT of Jammu & Kashmir and the States of Assam, Bihar, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Jharkhand, Kerala, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh.

The reply to another question, Dr Jitendra Singh, who is also Incharge India Meteorological Department (IMD), stated that India Meteorological Department (IMD) is continuously working on improving operational forecasting models for various weather and climate extreme events to help farmers and others.

The Minister informed the House that the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) has launched an ambitious and well-resourced research programme on mission mode, called the Monsoon Mission. The first phase of the mission was implemented during 2012-2017 and the second phase (2017-22) is underway.

The reply by Dr Jitendra Singh also gave detail that IMD is issuing Impact Based Forecast (IBF) which gives details of what the weather will do rather than what the weather will be. It contains the details of impacts expected from the severe weather elements and guidelines to the general public about do's and don'ts while getting exposed to severe weather conditions like cyclone, heat wave, thunderstorm and heavy rainfall. IMD also runs an operational Agrometeorological Advisory Services (AAS) viz Gramin Krishi Mausam Sewa (GKMS) scheme for the
