SRINAGAR: In pursuance to the Government order vide No 83-3K (DMRRR) of 2021 dated 29 November, 2021, regarding the sanction to the adoption of the scheme for granting ex-gratia Assistance under SDRF, the District Administration Srinagar on the directions of Chairman District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Mohammad Aijaz Asad has launched online facility for Next of kins of Covid-19 victims for which an official link www.srinagar.nic.in - ex-gratia Assistance claim (death due to Covid-19) has been created.

According to the notification issued by DDMA here on Wednesday, now, the NOK's of the Covid-19 victims who have not submitted the required documents, so far are asked to submit the same on the above created link immediately for speedy disposal of the cases.

The documents to be submitted include Death Certificate (due to COVID-19), Aadhaar linked Account No. with IPSC code of the claimant, Copy of Aadhar card of the claimant, Address proof of the claimant and Legal Heirship certificate or adoption deed issued by competent Authority for establishing kinship with the Covid-19 deceased.

(c) Parental income ceiling per annum for Pre-matric, Post-matric Scholarships is Rs. 2.50 lakh and for Top Class Education is Rs. 6.00 lakh. (d) Not more than two disabled children of the same parents will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme. In case, if the second child is a twin, the scholarship under these schemes will be admissible to both twins. (e) Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, he/she would not get scholarship for a second (or subsequent) year. (f) A scholarship holder under these schemes will not hold any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded any other scholarship/stipend, the student can exercise his/her option for either of the two scholarships/stipends, which is more beneficial to him/her and should inform the awarding authority through the Head of the Institution about the option exercised.
