CRIME REPORT

9 years old boy crushed to death

AKHNOOR: A nine years old child was crushed to death by a school van on Tuesday.

As per report, a nine years old Krish Sharma, son of Raj Kumar, resident of village Agore Garhi, tehsil Bhalwal got hit by a school van (JK02CX 4514), when he was riding a bicycle with his elder brother. Locals immediately shifted him to Sub District Hospital SDHI Akhnor where doctors declared him as brought dead.

On information, SHO Joginder Chib along with team rushed to spot and arrested school van driver besides seizing school van. Body of Krish Sharma was handed over to family for last rites.

Bike-lifter arrested, 4 stolen bikes recovered

SAMBA: Police on Tuesday arrested a bike-lifter and recovered 4 stolen bikes.

As per details, during the investigation of FIR No. 213/2022 under section 379 of IPC registered at Police Station Samba regarding theft of a Scooty (Honda Activa JK21G/3822), a team of Police Station Samba led by SHO Samba, Insp Deepak Jasrotia under supervision of DySP Hqrs Mohd Usman, nabbed a suspect namely Gourav Sharma alias Rohit, son of Varinder Sharma, resident of near Ashta Purani Mata Mandir, Kathua, at present Sanba. On his disclosure, 3 more two-wheelers were recovered, stolen by accused which included a Motorcycle Honda CB twister bearing registration number PB35T/8450 Chassis no. XME4JC47FMD7007872X; Motorcycle Hero Honda Splendor bearing registration No JK08F/3034 Chassis no MBLHA10CGGHJC2073 and Motorcycle Super Splendor bearing registration No PB06M/6167 Chassis No MBLJA05EGA9M10451.



Three narco smugglers nabbed with heroin

SAMBA: Police on Tuesday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered heroin from their possession. Samba Police under overall supervision of SSP Dr Abhishek Mahajan arrested a drug peddler in jurisdiction of Police Station Vijaypur and

recovered approximately 5.75 gm Heroin (Chitta) from his possession. During patrolling, a Naka was established by Addl SP Samba, Surinder Choudhary assisted by SDPO Vijaypur Priyanka Kumari and SHO Vijaypur Inspr Tribhuvan Khajuria near Ishant Hotel, Gurha Mohr



Vijaypur. A person was found moving under suspicious circumstances. During frisking of suspect, 5.75 gm Heroin (Chitta) like substance was recovered from his possession, who was identified as Rinku Kumar, son of Dewan Chand, resident of Nagrota, Uttarbehani. He was arrested on the spot and contraband item was also seized. FIR 192/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Vijaypur.

In another instance, a party of Police Station Samba headed by SHO Samba Inspr Deepak Jasrotia assisted by PSI Rajat Sharma under supervision of DySP Inspr Samba, Mohd Usman, while on patrolling duty noticed a suspect near village Mandhera, Samba. On seeing police, he tried to escape but was apprehended due to swift action by Police. During search, approximately 6.8 gm Heroin (Chitta) like substance recovered from his possession. The accused was identified as Alaf Din alias Alfu alias Ballu, son of Ghulam Hussain, resident of Chack Manga Gujran, Tehsil Samba and FIR No 303/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Samba. Similarly in another incident, a party of Police Station Samba, while on patrolling duty near Bhudwani Samba, apprehended another drug peddler namely Narinder Singh, son of Rattan Singh, resident of Tapyal, Ghagwal. During frisking, approximately 1.7 gm heroin (Chitta) was recovered from his possession. FIR No. 304/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Samba.

DFCO team seals 2 medical stores for not maintaining sales records

RAMBAN: Drug and Food Control Organization carried-out inspection of various medical stores in far-flung areas of Ramban to check the registration, authorization and record of availability and sale of medicines, besides checking standard parameters of medicines, available in the chemists' shops.

On the directions of Deputy Commissioner Ramban, Mussarat Islam, the Drug Control Officer (DCO), Intiyaz Ahmed inspected various medical stores including Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendra in Sub-Gool. During the inspections, the inspection team sealed 2 medical stores for not maintaining sales records under the Drugs & Cosmetic Act 1940. Besides, 2 drug samples were also lifted from medical stores for determin-

ing their quality and purity. The chemists were warned of severe action under extant rules in case the mentioned deficiencies are not removed within a stipulated period of time. They were instructed to install CCTV cameras and ensure that the sale of Drugs is made only on a valid and proper prescription. The department also requested the general public to keep a vigil on persons involved in the trade of Narcotics & Psychotropic drugs and inform the authorities if they found any violation of rules. The team also advised the people to desist from taking medicines and health services from any unregistered medical stores and medicos.

Couple dies as car plunges into gorge at Doda

DODA: A retired government official and his wife died on Tuesday after their car skidded off the road and plunged into a deep gorge in Doda district, an official said. According to police, the accident occurred in Jathia area of Doda, on Batote-Doda-Kishtwar NHW244, when a vehicle (JK02CN-5892) was on its way to Batote from Doda, went out of control and fell into a deep gorge. Police, volunteers and locals rushed to the spot and shifted injured couple to nearby hospital, where doctors declared wife as probably dead, while husband was shifted to Associate Hospital GMC Doda, where he also succumbed to injuries. Medical Superintendent GMC Doda, Dr Yudhvir Singh, while confirming death of both deceased, informed that husband succumbed to injuries. The deceased were identified as Retired TSO Mangat Ram (62), son of Damodar Thakur; resident of Chilli, Bhallea and his wife Shakuntala Devi (58).

Sub Inspector dies in accident

Illegal mining: Murderous attack on Crusher Manager

KATHUA: A crusher manager was attacked with sharp-edged weapons in connection with mining under Lakanpur Police Station, in which he got injured and was shifted to Pathankot hospital for treatment. Injured has named two mining businessmen of Punjab in his statement give to Police, which is investigating the matter.

According to detailed information, Sandeep Mahajan alias Sonu, son of Rampal, resident of Taragarh, Pathankot who is Manager of a crusher in Kathua was called on Tuesday afternoon by one of his acquaintances on pretext of showing him a rented room near RTO office in Lakanpur. When Sonu went to that place, two youth attacked him with sharp-edged weapons and thereafter fled from the spot. Police was informed after which shifted the injured to hospital for treatment. In hospital, the injured held Joshi, a mining businessman from Punjab and his relative Karanjev behind the attack and informed that he was attacked over a mining dispute.
