

## Rajouri incident: Ravinder seeks independent probe; adequate compensation, jobs for victims' families

RAJOURI: Senior Congress leaders led by JKPC Chief Spokesperson Ravinder Sharma Ex-MLC visited the families of two victims killed in Rajouri incident yesterday and shared the grief and sorrow of the families on behalf of the party rank and file besides seeking high level independent probe and adequate compensation and jobs for families..

Sharma expressed deep shock over the incident which resulted in to the death of two young boys leaving behind young widows and two minor children each. The families are very poor and belong to dalit samaj, who need to be helped out of the way, in the facts and circum-

Sharma said the incident is subject matter of investigation, but in the facts and circumstances, a high level independent probe or judicial enquiry should be held to bring out entire truth about the incident.

ity with the victims families and supported their genuine demand of jobs to the widows, free and quality education to their children besides adequate compensation of fifty lacs per family, as per their demand.

The party said that the border people have great respect for the institution of armed

forces and always fought Pakistan sponsored terrorism , shoulder to shoulder with our forces. We are together in fighting terrorism but transparency is back bone of rule of law. Let rule of law prevail and truth come out, without commenting upon the merits of investigation, which should be free , fair and independent.

CHENANI: Jammu Kashmir Teachers' Joint Action Committee ( JKT-JAC) on Saturday held a meeting at Chenani under the leadership of District President Lekh Raj Parihar and Zonal President Ajaz Ahmed Wani .

While speaking on the occasion Lekh Raj Parihar raised the burning issues of the teaching fraternity including comprehensive Transfer policy in favour of teachers appointed under ReT scheme, Regularisation of ReTs who have completed 5 years ReT period and conversion of RRETs to Teachers Grade II/ III , Release of in situ and other arrears of the teachers , Scraping of NPS and inclusion of NPS employees for Old Pension Scheme, raising of Grade of teachers at par with their counter parts in other UTs , DPC of teachers which is pending for last 9 years.

Meanwhile JKTJAC showed strong resentment against non release of salary for the month of November 2022 of hundreds of teachers and masters of zone Chenani on pretext of updating of JKHRMS due to which they are suffering badly . They also showed concern on the slow pace of updating of the same and suggested to expedite the process by involving the exercise at pay centre level. On the occasion JKTJAC

leadership submitted a written Memorandum to ZEPO Chenani and warned that if their salary for both the months along with DA arrears is not released before 5th of January 2023 , they will hold a protest to gherao the office and for this sole responsibility will be of ZEPO OFFICE CHENANI.
