## POLYTHENE CARRY BAGS LESS THAN 120 MICRONS THICKNESS BANNED FROM 31<sup>ST</sup> DECEMBER, 2022

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change Government of India has issued notification No. G.S.R. 571 (E) dated 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021 vide which manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of identified single use plastic (SUP) items is prohibited with effect from the July 01,2022 and as per Rules, 4(1) (c) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended in 2021) "Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic, shall not be less than one hundred and twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022.

This notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Stockists, Retailers, Shopkeepers, e-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishment (Malls/ Market Place/Shopping Centres/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of polythene less than one hundred and twenty (120) microns with effect from 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022.

Action as deemed fit under Environmental Protection Act, 1986 including seizure of goods, levying of Environmental Compensation, closure of operation of Industries/ Manufacturing units, Commercial Establishments, shall be taken against the violators of the Notification.
