## J&K Climbers Shivani, Arun Deep leave for Nilgiri Cup

JAMMU: Shivani Charak and Arun Deep Singh, both international sport climbers of J&K, left on Sunday for Wellington (Tamil Nadu) to compete in the Nilgiri Cup.

The competition is being organized by Indian Mountaineering Foundation, the apex body for mountaineering and sport climbing in India, in association with Army Adventure Wing from December 21 to 22, 2022.

Only those sport climbers who are selected by the respective IMF Zones are eligible to compete in this competition.

Accordingly, only two climbers of J&K Shivani Charak and Arun Deep Singh who had won three gold medals and one gold medal respectively in the

North Zone Sport Climbing Competition became eligible to participate in this national ranking competition.

Earlier, Shivani and Arun who were in Indonesia for specialized speed climbing training for two months under a world class coach, had no plans to compete in this competition but when it was notified by IMF that results in this competition would affect the overall national ranking of a

climber and of course selection for the forthcoming Asia Cup Boulder to be hosted by India in March 2023, both of them had to leave their training midway to compete in this competition.

Before their departure for Wellington Shivani and Arun called on Shawetia Khajuria, General Secretary and Sumit Khajuria, Vice President of Mountaineering Association of J&K. Both

climbers were promised all possible help for their preparation specifically for selection in the Indian Sport Climbing team for the Asian Games to be held in China next year and Olympic Games at Paris in France in 2024. Shawetia and Sumit Khajuria wished them good luck for the Nilgiri Cup and hoped that they would perform to their full potential and bring laurels to J&K.

## 1st Test Kuldeep returns career-best figures in India's massive 188-run win

CHATTOGRAM: Wrist-spinner Kuldeep Yadav registered his career-best match figures as India quickly wrapped up Bangladesh's second innings for a comprehensive 188-run win in the opening Test, here Sunday.

Needing four wickets to pocket the win, India finished the job in 11.2 overs, bowling the hosts out for 324 after the hosts began at overnight score of 276 for six. Left-arm wrist spinner Kuldeep scalped two of the remaining four batters while Mohammed Siraj and Axar Patel took one wicket each.

Kuldeep, who cherished an impressive five-wicket haul in the first innings, added three more wickets in the second Bangladesh innings to finish with match figures of 8 for 113. "I love bowling with Kookaburra balls, it gives me better grip and control, compared to the SG ball," said Kuldeep after the win. "If I were not playing cricket, it would have been very challenging but I have played a lot of white-ball matches. I have played IPL and with red ball India A matched, so my rhythm was set."
