

CRIME REPORT

4 drug-peddlers booked under PSA

AWANTIPORA/ BUDGAM: Continuing efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Monday booked 4 notorious drug-peddlers under PIT NDPS act in Awantipora besides, arresting a drug-peddler along with huge quantity of contraband substance in Budgam.

In Awantipora, Police booked 4 notorious drug peddlers under PIT NDPS act after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent authority. The accused were identified as Bakhtawar Ahmad Makroo son of Late Ab Rahim Makroo resident of Gulzapora Batpora, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat son of Late Abdul Ahad Bhat, Ab Qayoom Bhat son of Late Abdul Khaliq Bhat, both residents of Larkipora Padganpura and Tariq Ahmad Mir son of Late Abdul Gani Mir, son in law of Mohd Ahsan Mir, resident of Kawani Awantipora.

It is pertinent to mention that accused were involved in NDPS cases registered in various Police Stations and were promoting drug abuse by supplying drugs to local youth. Subsequently, cases were duly processed and after obtaining sanctions from the competent authority, the arrested drug peddlers were detained under PIT NDPS act.

Meanwhile in Budgam, a Police party of Police Post Hardipanzo during area domination at Waragam Beerwah, intercepted a suspect identified as Tariq Ahmad Malik, son of Ali Mohammad Malik, resident of Waragam Beerwah. During search, huge quantity of contraband (39 Charas sticks) weighing 1.045 Kg were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR 169/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Beerwah and investigation started.

Railway Police returns lost jewellery to owner

Pilgrim dies of cardiac arrest

KATRA: A devotee who had come to pay obeisance at Mata Vaishno Devi died due to cardiac arrest near Police Post Market, Charan Paduka Temple on Mata Vaishno Devi route.

The devotee was identified as Babu Lal (47), son of Padam Ram, resident of Adarsh Nagar, Shahjahanpur, Mandi, Delhi. As soon as information was received, the Shrine Board personnel along with police rushed to the spot. The devotee was brought to dispensary at Banganga where doctors declared him as brought dead. The body has been sent to Government Hospital Katra for postmortem.

Two bikers injured in road accident

KATRA: Two persons got injured after two bikes coming from opposite direction collided head-on at Katra-Reasi road at village Agar Jitto, about 5 Km from Katra. The injured were identified as Rahul Sharma (21), son of Sudesh Kumar and Sahil Verma (18), son of Sanjeev Kumar, both residents of Bagal, Katra.

According to information, Rahul Sharma was riding his bike (JK02 AN-32 85) while Sahil Verma, who was on other bike (JK 02AN- 2385) came from opposite direction and collided near village Agar Jitto due to which both riders got injured and were shifted to Government hospital, Katra for treatment where doctors referred Rahul Sharma to Government Medical College Jammu for advanced treatment, while other injured Sahil Verma is undergoing treatment at Katra. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

Theft case solved; thief arrested, 7 stolen vehicles recovered

JAMMU: Police on Monday solved a theft case by arresting a thief and recovered seven stolen vehicles.

As per details, on December 16, 2022, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Talab Tillo Jammu by one Sanjay Abrol, son of Lt Rattan Lal Abrol, resident of

Vikas Lane, Jammu, stating that his Scooty (JK02BM 1004) was stolen from parking area of Exodus at Talab Tillo, Jammu. FIR 152/2022 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station Nowabad and investi-



gation started. After this, a team of Police Post Talab Tillo under supervision of DySP Hqrs Swati Sharma led by SHO Nowabad Insprv Vijay Sharma assisted by Incharge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Sonu Choudhary, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up a suspect identified as Abass Khan, son of Bashir Ahmed, resident of Jakhani Udhampur, at present Bagwati Nagar, Jammu.

During sustained questioning, accused confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure 7 stolen vehicles were recovered including Scooty Activa bearing registration No JK02BM 1004; Scooty Activa bearing registration No JK02BN 3027; Scooty Activa bearing registration No JK02BA 2321; Scooty JK02AT 5984; motorcycle JK02CK 5271; a Splendor motorcycle Black Colour, Engine No - HA10AGHHGA8180 and a Splendor motorcycle, Black colour Chassis No.-MBL-HAWO94KHJ77513. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SP North Kulbir Handa.

AAP leader's brother among 4 dupes trader of Rs 27 lakh; two arrested, two absconding

JAMMU: Trikuta Nagar police has registered a case against four persons including brother of an AAP leader for duping a trader of Rs 27 lakh in name of providing him a JCB, however two of them have been arrested.

297/2022 under sections 476/468/109 of IPC was registered at Police Station Trikuta Nagar against four persons namely Ikhlq Hussain, son of Fayaz Hussain, resident of Lasana Surankote at present Sunjwan Jammu; Touseef (property dealer of Bhatindi & brother of AAP leader from Mendhar), Shakeel Ahmed, resident of Mendhar and Ishaq Ahmed. During raids police arrested two accused namely Ikhlq and Ishaq while Touseef and Shakeel are on run.

Four miscreants attack youth, snatch money
