The DGP expressed his happiness on witnessing the enthusiasm and energy

of the teams participating as well as of the large number of gathering which includes young children who have come from different areas to witness the football tournament despite cold. He said that football is very famous in Kashmir and this game is witnessing an increase of its followers each passing year.

 “I am overwhelmed to see that the number of participating teams in the championship has reached to 40”, he said, adding that participating teams are from different areas of J&K that is an achievement in itself.

Teams from outside J&K Referring to the Kathua Martyrs T-20 Cricket Tournament, the DGP

hoped that in the next year football teams from other States/UTs would participate in the championship adding that playing with different teams will enhance the quality of football here. The DGP then distributed kits including 200 footballs on the occasion.

Speaking to the media the DGP said that the event is being organised to pay tributes to our martyrs. He said that Jammu and Kashmir Police is organizing a number of tournaments and events throughout the year in order to provide platforms to the youth of J&K adding that these programmes bridge the gap between the department, youth & people and also spreads a message of peace in the society.

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Whereas the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a public Notice under endorsement No:- JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, dated:0 16-12-2020 inviting therein applications for re-registration/ validation of Pharmacist Registration certificates of all those persons who were registered as Pharmacist under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011, (1955,A,D);

Whereas, the above exercise was initiated in pursuane to provision (32C) incorporated in the Pharmacy Act. 1948 notified vide S.o No:- **3465(E), Dated:- 05th of October, 2020;**

Whereas, the above applicant namely **Mr. Lal Chand S/o Mr. Dharam Chand R/o Katal Batal, P.O Kandoli Nagrota, District-Jammu** uploaded an application in the Online Portal of J&K Pharmacy Council for re-registration Under (32C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 vide Form reference No:- PHAR021795, dated:- 27-10-2021;

Whereas, upon scrutiny of the uploaded documents submitted from the applicant end, it was observed that the **“Secondary School Examination (Matric-10th) Certificate does not match with the records Available with erstwhile J&K Pharmacy Council (existing under repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011)”;**

Whereas, the observations highlighted herein above suggests that the above person has acquired registration as Pharmacist by adopting unfair means, misrepresentation as also concealment of material facts;

Whereas, the above Person was offered an opportunity to provide his response in the matter through show cause/ personnel appearance notice vide this office letter bearing No:- JKPC/32C/ SCN/ PHAR021795/2343-47 Dated:- 20-09-2022;

Whereas, the applicant was once again afforded an opportunity through a final notice for personal appearance vide this office letter no:JKPC/2022/32C/PHAR021795/20397-2402 dated:- 28-10-2022.

Whereas the applicant has failed to respond to the communications reflected in para supra and as a result of it the constitutional right that accrued to the applicant to explain his position in the matter stands forfeited;

Now, therefore the undersigned in exercise of powers vested under Section (36) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 reject the claims of the applicant to allow him for re-registration as Pharmacist in terms of Section 32(C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
